Early Childhood:

Registration Update as of April 21st:

Enrollment is still holding steady. We have 68 students enrolled in Early Childhood Classes:

- Little Miners AM: 11
- Little Miners PM: 8
- Little Rangers 3 Day: 25
- Little Rangers 5 Day: 24

We held our combined Early Childhood & Kindergarten registration open house featuring a “Kindergarten Signing Day” opportunity. The event was a huge success. We had 31 Kindergarten enrollments and 12 Early Childhood registrations just that night. We are currently at 36 total EC registrations for the 2026-27 School year.

Community Education Updates:

- Our April Community Movie Night featured “G.O.A.T” and had approximately 34 people in attendance (it was hard to count in the dark and concessions was busy).
- The May Movie Night will be Friday, May 15th and will feature the movie “Hoppers”. We are trying to coordinate for the CRES PBIS reward to be that afternoon so that they can also see this movie.
- Storybook Theatre was here March 23 - 28th and put on “The Little Mermaid”. We had a total of 42 youth participating.
 - The public performances brought in 351 in paid attendance with many more preschoolers attending (who got in free.) The total ticket sales was \$1613 and total registration fees collected was \$1,170 (three students received a scholarship) for total revenue of \$2,783.
 - Storybook Theatre will be back July 20-25th to present “Twice Upon a Time.”
- We have the spring edition of our adult enrichment bird identification class coming up on Thursday, April 23rd.
- The next “Brushes at the Bridge” with Lakes Area Custom is scheduled for Thursday, May 7th.
- We have started promoting our inaugural vendor fair that will be held on Saturday, June 20th.
- I would like to share that my final official day with Crosby-Ironton School District will be Friday, May 22nd. Serving this community has been a truly meaningful experience, and I am incredibly grateful for the relationships built, the work accomplished, and the continued commitment to our students and families. Thank you for the opportunity to be part of this district.
