RE: Approval of Consolidated District Plan

Background Information: The Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) provides funds to schools for the purpose of improving academic achievement. It ensures that all children have a fair, equal, and effective opportunity to obtain a high-quality education that enables them, at a minimum, to reach proficiency on challenging State academic standards and assessments.

Administrative Considerations: The Consolidated District Plan, a crucial component of our compliance with the Every Student Succeeds Act, is a prerequisite for District 7's application for Title I, II, III, IV, and IDEA funding. This plan outlines our goals for the year and how we intend to use the funds to enhance our educational programs.

Title I: \$149,835 -Improving academic achievement of disadvantaged students

Title II: \$21,945 -Professional development for teachers and school leaders

Title III: \$ 0 -Language instruction for English Learners

Title IV: \$ 21,945 -Student support and academic achievement

IDEA: \$237,131 -Special Education

IDEA Preschool: \$8,152 -Special Education

The grant funds will only become available once the BOE approves this plan and the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) accepts it.

Recommendation: I am recommending that the Board of Education approve the Consolidated District Plan to access the Federal funds mentioned above.
