DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

At the direction of the Board of Trustees, the Superintendent shall appoint a District Disciplinary Hearing Officer to conduct hearings and make decisions concerning long-term suspension or expulsion of a **student pupil**. Pursuant to NRS 392.467, all district disciplinary hearings shall be closed to the public. The Hearing Officer shall attempt to schedule each hearing as soon as reasonably possible after receipt of notice and request for hearing from a school.

The Hearing Officer, principal, parent/legal guardian and student will each agree to, sign and receive a copy of The Student Disciplinary Action Form at the hearing. A copy of this form will be placed in the student's disciplinary file.

~~Proceedings are tape recorded, and parents shall be provided a copy of the taped proceedings. The Hearing Officer shall provide the parent notice in writing of the action taken and the rights to appeal the decision. The Hearing Officer shall cause the notice of the action taken to be placed in the student's school disciplinary file and shall submit written summation of such action to the Board of Trustees.~~
