

TRAFFIC AND PARKING PROCEDURES

The building administrator/designee, with assistance from the Maintenance and Operations Supervisor, Transportation Supervisor and local traffic authorities, is responsible for accommodating the flow of traffic on school roadways and placing appropriate signs to facilitate such traffic flow. Building administrators will have the responsibility for the assignment of parking areas to staff, students and visitors to the buildings. Parking areas will be designated and maintained for handicapped persons as mandated by law. Parking privileges may be suspended or revoked.

The Board of Trustees is conscious of the schools bearing a measure of responsibility for the safety of ~~children~~ **students** traveling to and from school but believes that primary responsibility for traffic on the streets and sidewalks rests with law enforcement authorities.

The Board may appropriate annually a sum of money, which will be considered a share in the support of the number of crossing guards required for safe travel of students to and from the public schools. ~~The crossing guards who are considered the school district's share will be paid directly by the District.~~

This arrangement will continue during the time that law enforcement assumes the responsibility for recruiting, employing, training, supervising and evaluating the school crossing guard staff. The school district, in addition to sharing in the wages of the crossing guards, will cooperate in any way possible to render the crossing guard more effective and to provide a safer system for the pedestrian students.

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
