

ATTENDANCE MONITORING AND ACCOUNTING

The Superintendent/Designee shall establish the procedures for checking and reporting pupil attendance as prescribed by the laws of the State of Nevada and the regulations of the Nevada Department of Education.

Research and experience show a strong relationship between poor attendance in the early grades and the likelihood that a student will later drop out of school. Conversely, it is well recognized that there is a high correlation between regular school attendance, school success and achievement. Therefore, good attendance shall be emphasized from the time a child enrolls in school to 12th grade through the prescribed number of days that a pupil is subject to compulsory attendance and enrolled in a school. **The student** must be in attendance ~~for the pupil~~ **in order** to obtain credit or to be promoted to the next higher grade.

Attendance is a shared responsibility of students and parents/legal guardians, school staff and community.
