

ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL PROGRAM

Nye County School District will offer an alternative education program that will meet the needs of individual attendance areas to include students in grades 3-12.

This alternative school program may be designed for students who are not able to be successful in the structure of a regular school setting. Students will complete coursework using the District-approved on-line distance education curriculum.

The alternative school program may be located within a school or on a separate campus and may operate before, after or during regular school hours.

The District will require the following:

1. Students in alternative school programs meet federal, State and District policies and procedures.
2. Evidence of student progress.
3. Admittance must be available to all the District students on a non-discriminatory basis.
