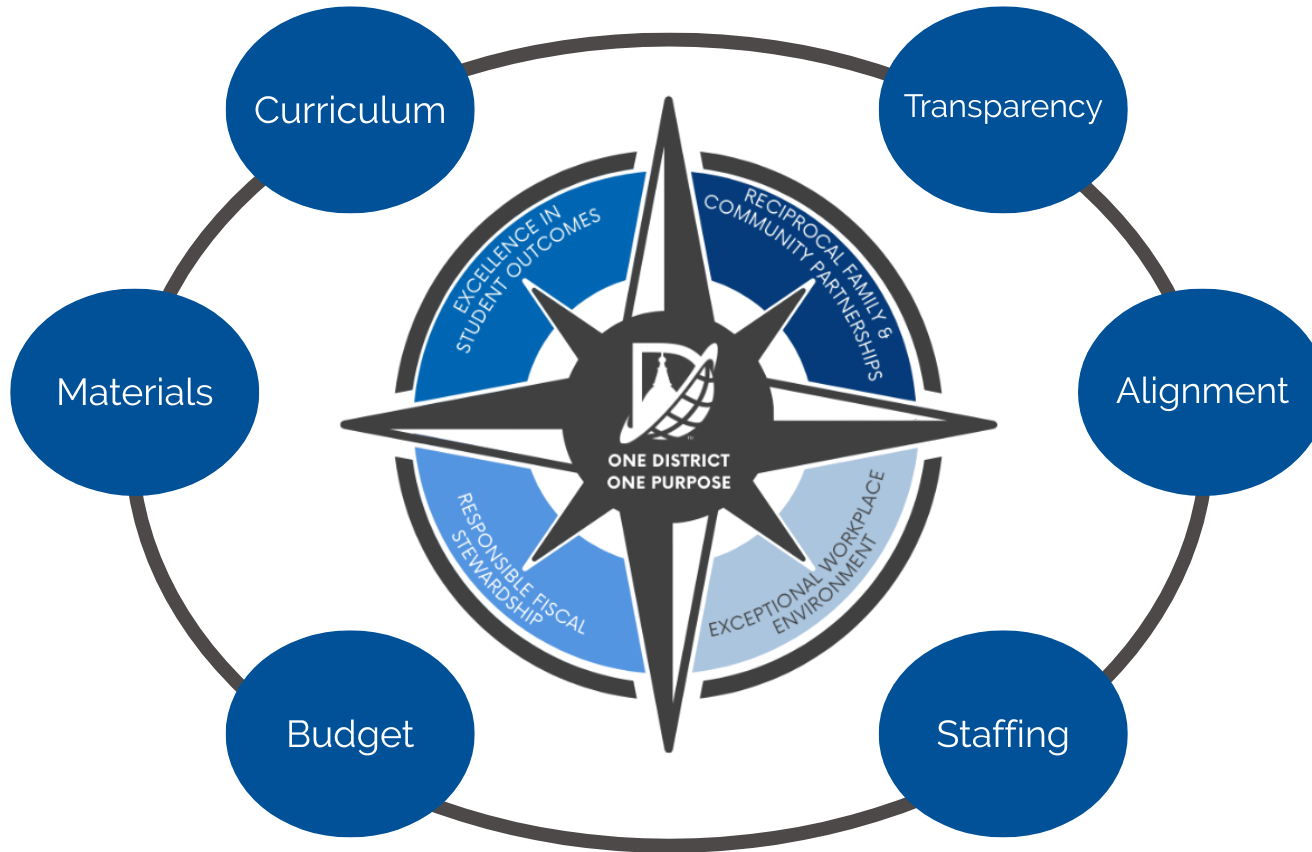

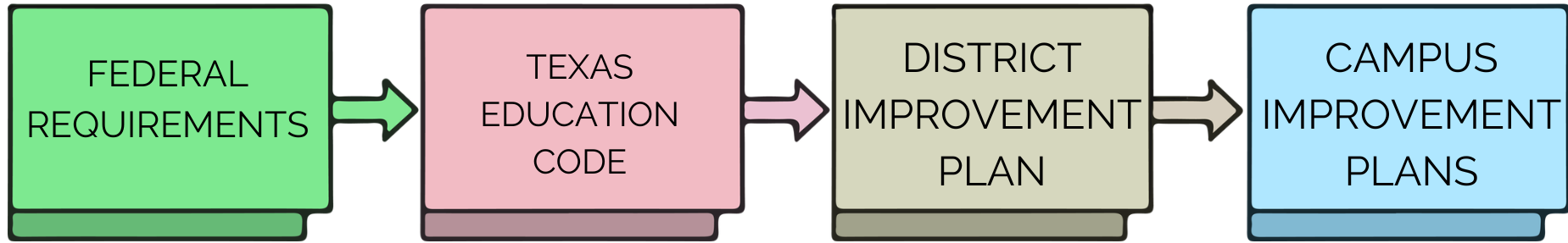

DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT PLAN ALIGNMENT



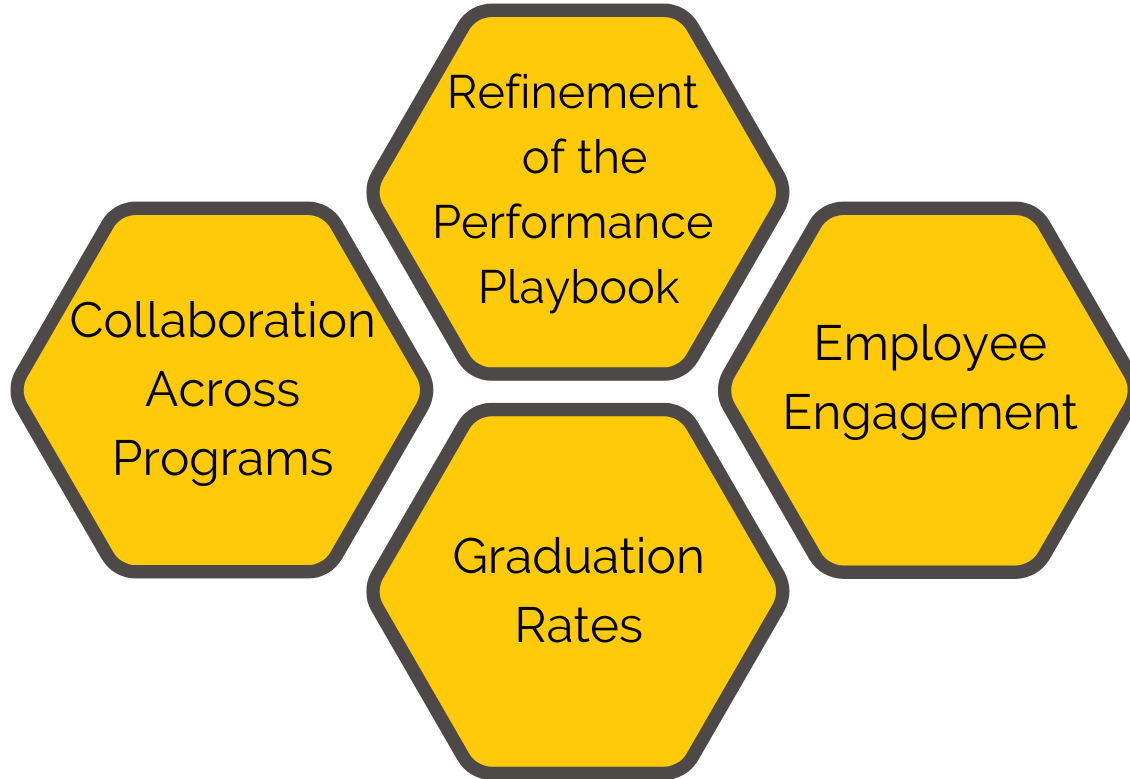

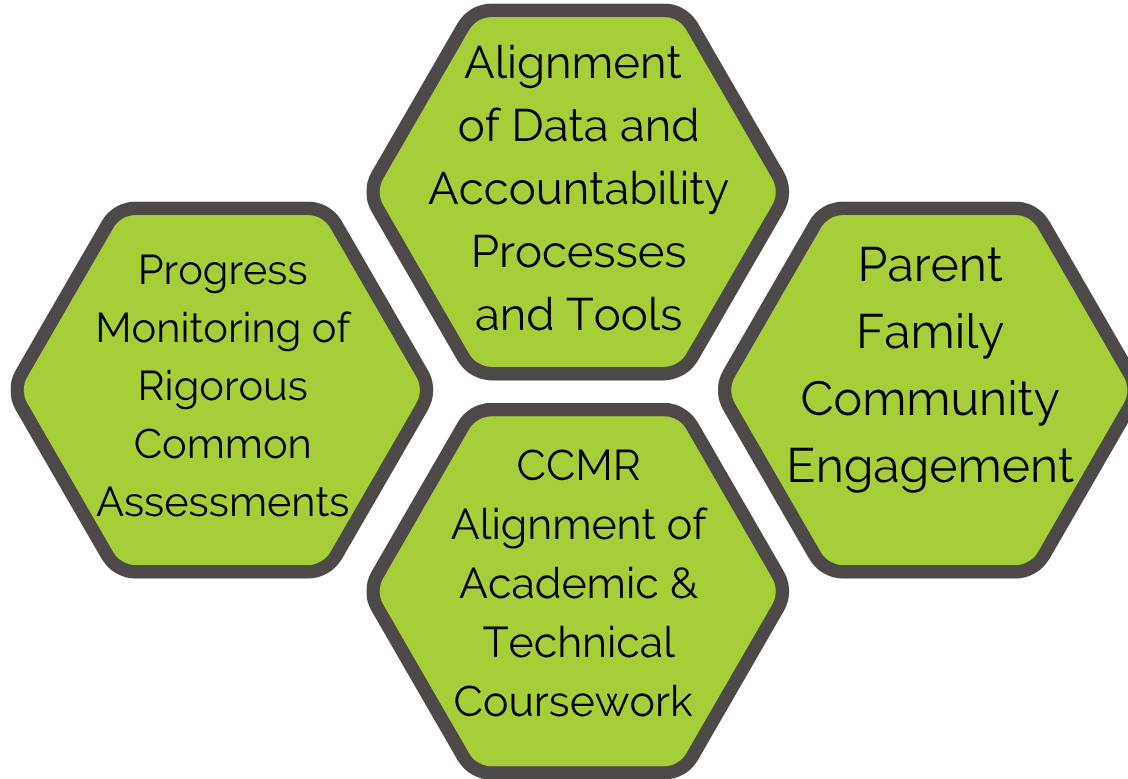
