The meeting was called to order at 3:40 pm by Daye Stone at HVHS with the pledge of allegiance. The minutes from the June meeting were read and Carla made a motion to accept the minutes, Teri seconded the motion and the minutes were accepted unanimously.

Daye reviewed the purpose of Site Council and the TRSD and HVHS Mission Statements.

We received the ERG Guides back from Print Services and they have been placed on clipboards and hung in rooms. Some extra time was spent with new staff looking at the basic things to how to handle fire drills and lock down procedures. We had a fire drill on Freshman First Day to help them to go through the procedure and know where to go and find their Team Leader out front.

PLC's will be held two Fridays a month. The district scheduled Aces Training one day a month for us. The entire staff will attend and classified staff will adjust their workday or they will be paid for their extra time to attend. The collaboration grant will present and PD opportunities will be available, there will be a wide range of PD offerings.

Our Teacher leaders went to a training with administrators, the PLC's will be better data driven this year. We will be looking at our school and what the needs are. The PLC leaders will meet and plan how to facilitate PLC's.

Serve Grants Pass replaced the wood on our bleachers and they repainted them and reinstalled them with new bolts. They look very nice and are much safer.

Many volunteers have been working on the softball field. We are ready to roll the turf after steps are poured around the dugouts. We have been waiting on the fire danger to be cleared so should be ready the end of this week or next week. The curtain drain has been put in outside of the outfield.

The Center for Student Success is the name of the new center for our Graduation Coach and Career and College Advocate. We got the room painted and furniture moved in to the Center.

We have blue flex paint for the curtain and Shawn Bellenbaum will be painting the front of the commons blue and the curtain.

Dale Fisher is the testing coordinator for Essential Skills and will be looking at the data for all grades. He will be tracking kids and will frequently sharing the data with our staff.

Our Veterans Day Assembly will be on November 9th. We have sent out invitations to all that attended last year and we are getting RSVP's for speakers in classrooms and Veterans that will be attending the assembly.

Our Booster Club Dinner Auction will be on Saturday, November 11, 2017. It will be held at the Fairgrounds.

Ben said we need more in depth training for Edgenuity. Ben is asking if he will get an e-mail or how he will be notified when he is assigned students from other schools. He is the Art teacher of record for all middle and high schools.

We will be scheduling our Site Council meetings on the second Wednesday of each month. October 11 will be our next meeting.
