**AGENDA ITEM: Consideration of Removing the Six Semester Credit Hour Minimum Charge of Tuition and Fees for Huntsville Students**

The Administration recommends that the Board remove the minimum six semester credit hour charge of tuition and fees for Huntsville students beginning in Fall 2026. Huntsville students will be billed on a per-credit-hour basis the same as students at the main campus.

**Detail**

Removal of the six credit hour minimum was approved by the Board at the regular meeting on April 23, 2020, but it was applied only to students on the main campus. The six credit hour minimum was not changed for Huntsville students, probably because the sudden need to respond to the pandemic superceded all other considerations. The Administration wants to remove the six credit hour minimum for Huntsville students because there is no justification for billing Huntsville students differently than students on the main campus.

**Fiscal Implications**


About 100 Huntsville students register for a single three-credit course each semester (Fall, Spring & Summer). The college will collect \$226.50 less from each student. The annual impact will be a reduction in revenue of about \$67,950.
