Special Education Enrollment Trends

The prevalence rate for students identified as eligible for special education in Bristol fluctuates monthly and had ranged from 19.18% to 21.94% during the previous school year. As of October 1, 2020, the prevalence rate in Bristol is 20.81%, with 1675 of 8048 Bristol Public School students identified as eligible for special education programming. Since April 2020, 2 students have registered with BPS having already been enrolled in Out of District Placements for their special education programming.

Of all newly enrolled students during the month of September 2020, 8.73% of students were eligible for special education services at the time of registration.
