2025-2026 Memorandum of Understanding

Between Junior Achievement of Oklahoma, Inc. and:

School District: Stillwater Public Schools/Stillwater High School

School &/or Grade: 10th-12 grades

School Administrator: Ashley Moore, Director of Secondary

The goal of this *Memorandum of Understanding* (MOU) is to insure a successful partnership between Junior Achievement of Oklahoma (JA) and (STILLWATER HIGH SCHOOL) in the execution of JA Finance Park for all 10th grade students, approximately 500 students, for the 2025-2026 school year. This MOU is designed to outline the responsibility of each partner to ensure maximum benefit to students as well as accountability to the generous donors providing funding for this program to occur.

Terms:

JA Responsibilities:

- Secure funding to provide JA Finance Park (JAFP) classroom curriculum and simulation, focused on financial literacy, for effective student impact and graduation requirements for all 10th grade students enrolled in Personal Financial Literacy during the **2025-2026 school year**.
- Students will participate in the JAFP Virtual Simulation to fulfill curriculum requirements.
- Provide necessary training to teachers and JA volunteers required to deliver JAFP programming.
- Provide program resources to educators and printed student workbooks for all students.
- Provide JAFP curriculum alignments to Oklahoma State Standards and Personal Financial Literacy Requirements, as requested.
- Provide one (1) on-site date for JAFP teacher training (if needed). Provide webinar training for those teachers not able to attend.
- Promote partnership with **Stillwater High School** to increase awareness of the successful partnership between each school, area business volunteers, and Junior Achievement
- Communicate with schools and/or district to ensure a successful collaboration and JAFP program delivery.

Stillwater High School Responsibilities:

- Convey Junior Achievement partnership and JA funding investment to all school staff participating.
- Virtual Simulation Only-Provide volunteers to teach a minimum of three extension activity lessons or volunteer during the virtual simulation to all classes using Virtual Simulation delivery. Volunteers must meet or exceed JA screening requirements and complete all JA of Oklahoma's forms.
- Communicate any changes in school staff (LOA, etc.) or student participation as they occur.
- Adhere to JA program guidelines for JA Finance Park.
