BOARD POLICY: BF (Local and Legal)

DISTRICT GOAL: Brazosport ISD will provide a rigorous and relevant learning experience to ensure that every student will B\*FutureReady

Background Information:

- Brazosport ISD’s mission is to graduate each student to be future-ready.
- Brazosport ISD has the opportunity to require students to achieve a measure of college, career, and military readiness as a required component for graduation.
- The measures for college, career, and military readiness truly aim students for future readiness beyond simply receiving a diploma upon graduation.
- The proposed policy would take effect for freshmen entering high school during the 2026-27 academic year.
- The proposed policy also allows for the establishment of a campus-based committee to review extenuating circumstances for students that would waive this requirement, similar to how the state provides for committees to meet to provide alternatives for up to two End-of-Course STAAR assessments for graduation.
