

Agreement For Services  
Student Assistance Program (“SAP”)

THIS AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES is entered into this 1<sup>st</sup> day of July, 2021 by and between Independent School District Number 93 of Pottawatomie County, Oklahoma (hereinafter “District”), and Gateway to Prevention and Recovery, Inc., an Oklahoma non-profit corporation (hereinafter “Gateway”)

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, District and Gateway, for and in consideration of their mutual promises and assurances, hereby contract and agree to be bound as follows:

EMPLOYEE: Gateway hereby agrees to provide one employee to perform services for and on behalf of District, as stated for the term of this agreement.

TERM: This agreement shall be in full force and effect for the 2021-2022 fiscal year.

CONSIDERATION: District agrees to pay to Gateway, upon execution of this agreement, in consideration of the promises agreed to herein, the sum of Five Thousand dollars (\$5,000), per annum.

DUTIES: Gateway hereby agrees that said employee shall perform the regular and routine duties of substance abuse counselors.

HOURS: The parties mutually agree that one employee shall work two (2) days a week at the Shawnee High School and/or on as needed basis one (1) day a week Shawnee Middle School.

SUPERVISION: The parties mutually agree that employee(s) shall perform the regular and routine duties of substance abuse counselors.

BENEFITS: The parties mutually agree that employee(s) shall be subject to the immediate and direct supervision of the building principal of any District building within which said duties are performed, as well as by employer, Gateway.

TERMINATION: There parties mutually agree that upon termination of employee’s employment or of this agreement, District shall have no obligations with regard to employee(s). Furthermore should either party lose grant funding specific to either position, termination of the agreement could be considered with a request by either party for action with a thirty (30) day wait period. At that time the total amount due Gateway would be prorated based on a daily rate.

ETHICS: Gateway hereby agrees that employee(s) shall perform all duties and services required under this agreement in accordance with the “Code of Professional Conduct of Drug and Alcohol Counselors” as promulgated by the Oklahoma Drug and Alcohol Professional Counselors Association.

INSURANCE: Gateway agrees to maintain during the term of this Agreement, or any renewal hereof, a professional liability insurance policy insuring Gateway for any liability arising from any act or omission of Gateway. Gateway shall furnish certificates of insurance to District upon request.

AMENDMENT: This agreement represents all of the duties, rights and covenants of the parties hereto and may be amended only upon written agreement by both parties.

SEVERABILITY: If any provision of this agreement is now, or hereafter, declared to be contrary to law then as to that provision only upon such finding by a court of competent jurisdiction it shall be void, all other provisions to remain in full force and effect.

This agreement shall be binding on the parties, their successors and assigns.
