Background Information and Rationale:

The District uses MSB School Services, LLC, to recoup some money when the District provides services to students which Medicaid might separately have to support. When the District provides certain services, generally in the area of special education, that are covered services by Medicaid, the District can be reimbursed for those services. However detailed records and submission of records is necessary for reimbursement. Accordingly, school Districts generally hire a contractor to help track and document expenses and coordinate the transmission of the data to the state.

The District last fall renewed with our current provider, MSB School Services, LLC. In that agreement was the option to reduce previous fees by \$18,500 for renewing for two years. The District originally approved an agreement for one year but would like to take advantage of the Discount by extending the agreement for two years.

This is a board item to allow the Superintendent to extend the Medicaid Consultation and Billing Agreement.

Support of Strategic Goals:

Fiscal Implication:

In theory, this program should pay for itself and bring additional funding. The program is set up such that the District will pay \$29,880 for fixed services and every dollar after \$149,400 100% is then returned to the District. After earnings of \$149,400 the District would pay 5% of each additional dollar as a fee and keep 95%. There have been some issues with the state such that previous items which drew funding appeared to be disallowed. The District received that funding in prior years but the disallowed funding (and this issue is a statewide issue not unique to Decatur ISD) was repaid and included in an amendment earlier in the current year.


Administrative Recommendation:
