Background

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) implemented a new consolidated plan in 2019 which all school districts must submit annually. The Consolidated District Plan allows grantees to answer one set of planning questions to meet requirements for all 12 of the federal formula grants that are available. Collecting and coordinating this information up front enables ISBE to streamline individual Fiscal Year 27 grant applications.

District 65 currently receives federal grant funds for Title I, (Improving Basic Programs Operated by State and Local Educational Agencies); Title II, (Preparing, Training and Recruiting High-Quality Teachers, Principals and Other School Leaders); Title III, (Language Instruction Educational Program); Title IV, (Part A - Student Support and Academic Enrichment Grants); IDEA, Part B - Flow Through, (Special Education Funding); and IDEA, Part B - Preschool, (Special Education Funding).

A copy of the plan that has been submitted to ISBE for approval is attached. Below are areas highlighted within this consolidated plan.
