SUBJECT: CCSD School Board Scholarships

Each year, the Board awards scholarships to graduating Craig High School seniors as well as to former Craig graduates pursuing post-secondary education. These scholarships are funded through your generous donations of monthly Board stipends and the interest earned on a \$50,000 certificate of deposit established specifically for this purpose.

This year, the scholarship fund has a balance of \$6,979. Of that amount, \$1,000.00 is being held for a deferred scholarship awarded to a 2024 graduate. That scholarship has not been requested to date and will expire at the end of the 2025-2026 school year.

With the remaining balance of \$5,979, the Board will determine the number of scholarships to award and how to allocate them between current graduates and former students. One of the two options below is recommended:

Option 1, total: \$5,250

- Three (3) scholarships of \$1,500 each to 2026 graduating seniors
- One (1) \$250 scholarship to the Student Board Representative
- Two (2) scholarships of \$250 each for continuing education students

Option 2, total: \$5,750

- Four (4) scholarships in the amount of \$1,250 each to 2026 graduating seniors
- One (1) \$250 scholarship to the Student Board Representative
- Two (2) scholarships of \$250 each for continuing education students

Thank you for your ongoing support of our students' futures.

Suggested motion:

Option #1: Approve three scholarships to the 2026 graduating seniors in the amount of \$1,500 each, one scholarship to the Student Board Representative in the amount of \$250, and two scholarships in the amount of \$250 each for continuing education.

Option #2: Approve four scholarships to the 2026 graduating seniors in the amount of \$1,250 each, one scholarship to the Student Board Representative in the amount of \$250, and two scholarships in the amount of \$250 each for continuing education.
