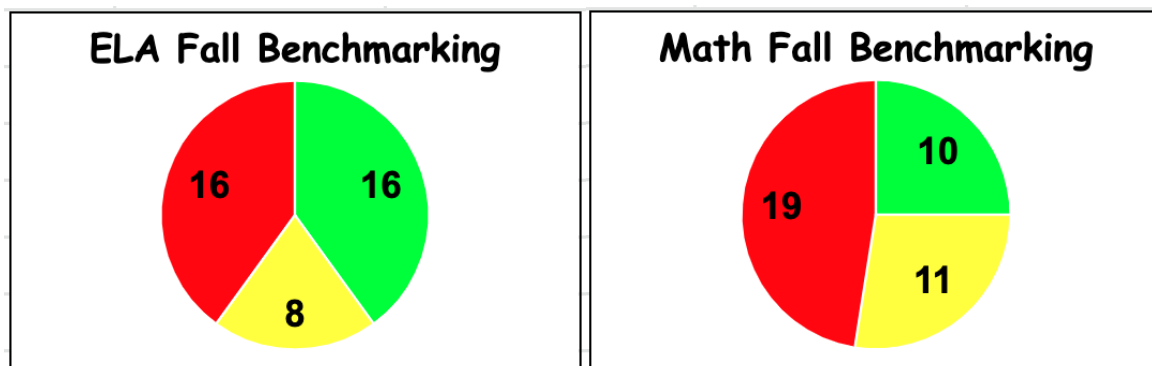


# Glendale & Big Sky Colony Schools

## November Board Report

The Aimsweb fall benchmark assessments have been completed at both Colony Schools. They also participated in the district writing assessment during the month of October. Although we saw many strengths in students reading and writing scores, math is an area in need of growth. At the Big Sky School, we will focus our Tier II and III intervention efforts primarily in grades 2-5 in ELA and in all grades for mathematics. At Glendale School, ELA intervention will target a few students at Tier II. The following are the combined Colony School's fall benchmarking scores based on Aimsweb ELA and mathematics testing:



### Principal's Instructional Goals & Action Steps

#### **Academic Goal for the 22-23 School Year:**

By June 1, 2023, Big Sky and Glendale Schools will decrease students in ELA and mathematics Tier III by 25% and increase Tier 1 by 25% as measured by Aimsweb end of year benchmarking assessment.
