

AUTOMATED EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATOR

The Board of Trustees, to the extent that money is available, may provide for the placement of an automated external defibrillator in each school and at each athletic facility maintained by the District. Each defibrillator must be appropriate for use on children and adults and be limited to use on school property and at school events.

The Board may accept the donation of a defibrillator that complies with standards established by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration as well as gifts, grants and donations for use in obtaining, inspecting and maintaining a defibrillator.

The school district shall ensure that each defibrillator is inspected and maintained on a regular basis. Any employee who will use a defibrillator is required to complete the training requirements of a course in basic emergency care of a person in cardiac arrest that includes training in the operation and use of an automated external defibrillator, conducted in accordance with the standards of the American Heart Association, the American National Red Cross or similar organization.
