

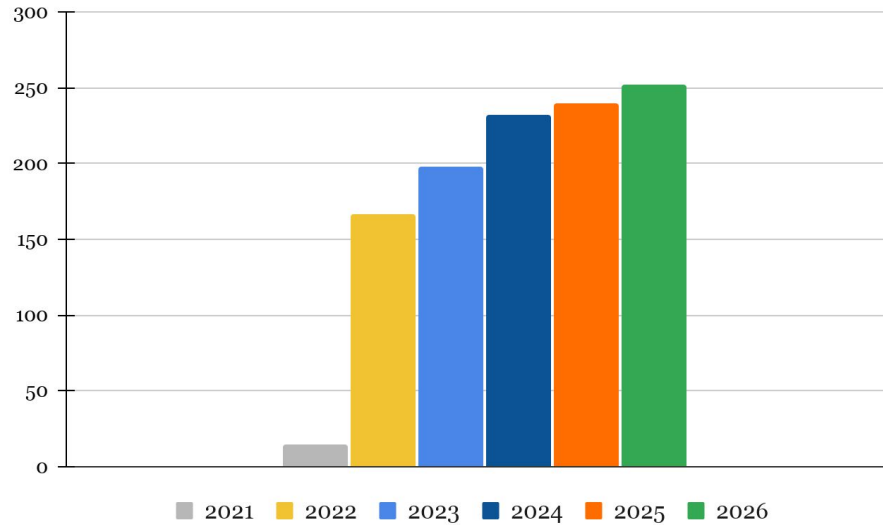

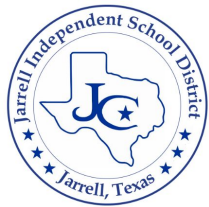
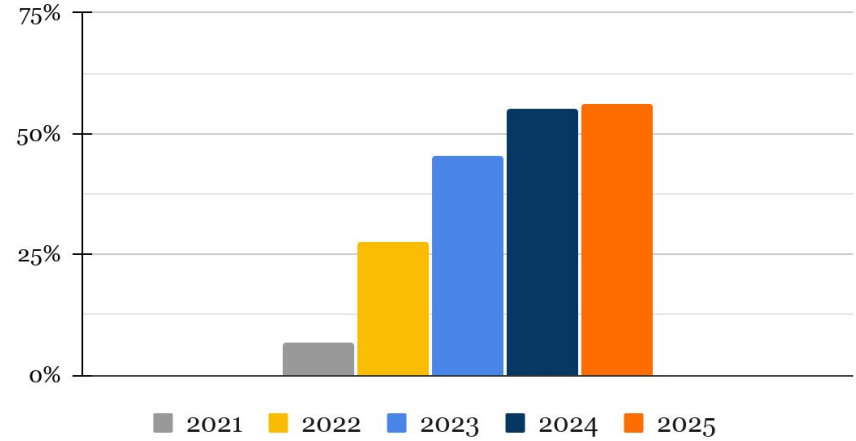

## Total Earned IBCs



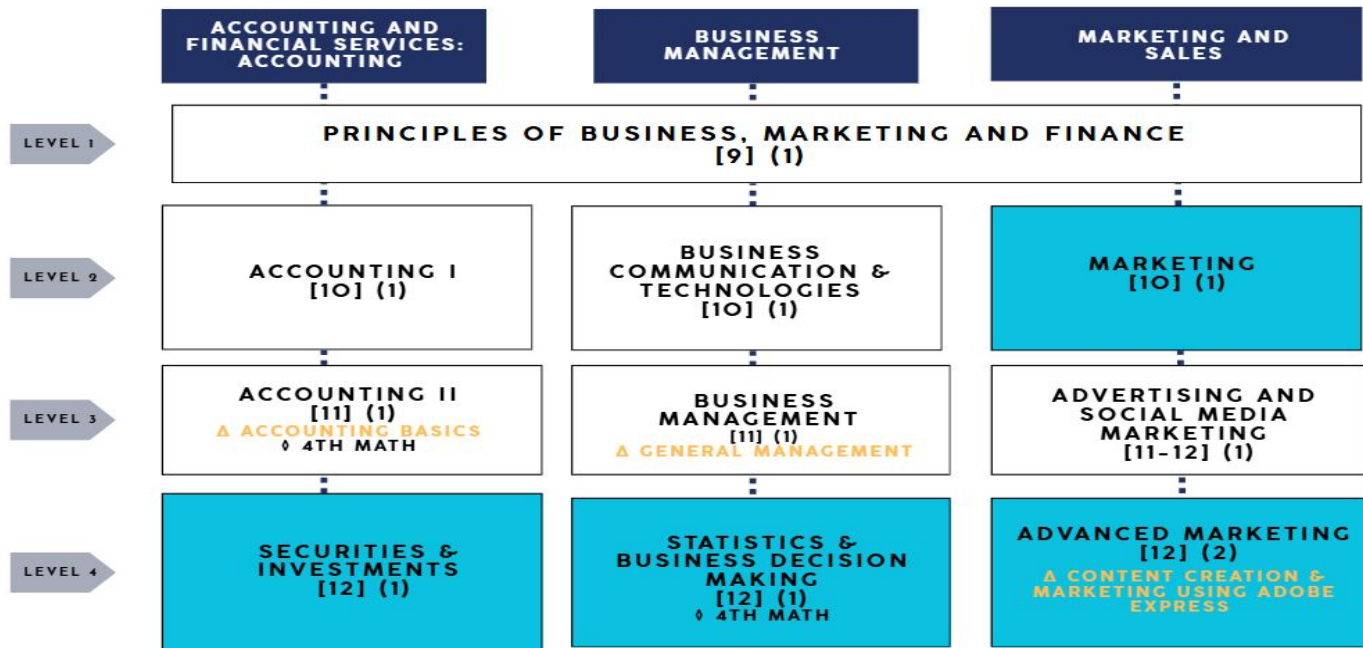
## Percent of Seniors Earning IBCs

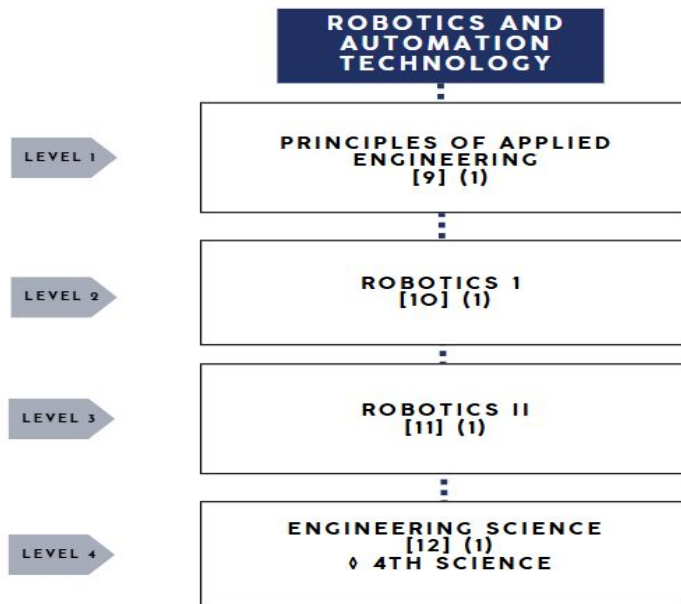
