STAFF CONDUCT

It is unlawful for a person employed in a position of authority (teacher/instructor, administrator, coach or paraprofessional or auxiliary non-professional employee who assists licensed personnel) by a public or private school from engaging in sexual conduct with a pupil who is 16 years of age or older, who has not received a high school diploma, a general educational development certificate or an equivalent documents; and ~~or 17 years of age~~ who is enrolled or attending the school at which the person is employed. Any employee convicted under NRS 201.540 shall be guilty of a category C felony. This policy does not apply if the employee is married to the student.

It is further the policy of this District that no employee shall engage in sexual conduct with any pupil of the Nye County School District. This policy does not apply if the employee is married to the student.
