RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DONATIONS

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 123B.02, Subd. 6 provides: "The board may receive, for the benefit of the district, bequests, donations, or gifts for any proper purpose and apply the same to the purpose designated. In that behalf, the board may act as trustee of any trust created for the benefit of the district, or for the benefit of pupils thereof, including trusts created to provide pupils of the district with advanced education after completion of high school, in the advancement of education;" and

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statutes 465.03 provides: "Any city, county, school district or town may accept a grant or devise of real or personal property and maintain such property for the benefit of its citizens in accordance with the terms prescribed by the donor. Nothing herein shall authorize such acceptance or use for religious or sectarian purposes. Every such acceptance shall be by resolution of the governing body adopted by a two-thirds majority of its members, expressing such terms in full;" and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the School Board of Owatonna Public Schools accepts with appreciation the following donations:

- \$250 from Costas Candies to Owatonna High School for State Student Council
- \$200 from The Blast, Inc. to Owatonna High School for State Student Council
- \$300 from Deml Heating & Air Conditioning, LLC to Owatonna High School for State Student Council
- \$250 from Advantage Cabinets, Inc. to Owatonna High School for State Student Council
- Pediatric reverse walker from anonymous to Washington Elementary
- \$280 from Music Boosters of Owatonna for Elementary Honor Choir participation fees
