BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

1) CarePortal Online Resource Agreement

In an effort to enhance support for student well-being and academic success, Stillwater Public Schools has established a partnership with Care Portal, a community-driven resource organization dedicated to connecting families in need with local resources. This collaboration enables the district to better address the essential needs of students, including access to food, clothing, and other crucial supports. Care Portal acts as a bridge, linking schools with local businesses, organizations, and volunteers who are able to provide assistance. By leveraging these community resources, Stillwater Public Schools aims to foster a more supportive environment, ensuring that all students have the foundation necessary to succeed in school and beyond. This initiative represents a significant step forward in aligning district goals with broader community support networks for the benefit of students and families. This is a new contract.

2) The Saville Center for Child Advocacy MOU

To formalize a collaborative partnership aimed at enhancing the support and services available to children in our district who are involved in abuse investigations. By establishing this MOU, we seek to ensure that our students have access to vital resources that promote their well-being and recovery. This collaboration underscores our commitment to prioritizing the safety and health of our students while facilitating a coordinated response to abuse cases. This is a new contract.
