DRIVERS LICENSE ELIGIBILITY

Pupils applying for a drivers license must submit a form to the principal of the school he/she attends providing verification that the pupil has complied with the minimum attendance requirements established by the Board of Trustees. If the pupil does not satisfy the attendance requirements and the principal/designee determines that a hardship exists and it would be in the best interests of the pupil or his/her family for the pupil to be allowed to drive, the principal/designee may sign the form.

If the pupil does not satisfy attendance requirements, including tardies, and no hardship is deemed to exist, a date must be set for a hearing and written notice of the hearing provided to the parent/legal guardian of the pupil. If it appears after investigation and a hearing that a pupil is a habitual truant, administrative sanctions may be imposed including, but not limited to, suspension of the drivers license of the pupil or prohibition from applying for a drivers license.
