Agenda Topic: Approval of Donation in Accordance with Board Policy CDC(Local)

Type of Item: Consent

Guiding Outcome: Responsible Fiscal Stewardship

Summary: Donation of \$25,000 made to Fred Moore Day Nursery School to support childcare assistance and family self-sufficiency initiatives, helping families in the community work or attend school.

Background Information/
Previous Board Action: The original \$25,000 award, approved on October 14, 2025, and the additional \$25,000 award, for a total of \$50,000, will greatly benefit families, 95% of whom are low- to moderate-income. Currently, no resources exist to provide temporary childcare assistance for families facing financial hardship, such as job loss, or for teen parents enrolled full-time in high school. With the Texas Child Care Subsidy wait-list at 95,000, many eligible families wait months before receiving assistance, preventing enrollment. These funds will help offset childcare costs until subsidy support becomes available.

Potential Operational Impact: These funds will help maintain and increase enrollment by enabling families to afford childcare and reducing gaps caused by financial hardship or subsidy delays.

Potential Financial Impact: This is a one-time donation.

Recommendation (Consent or
New Business Only): The Superintendent recommends approval of the Denton Housing Authority donation in the amount of \$25,000 to Fred Moore Day Nursery School.
