

8200**BUILDINGS-GROUNDS-PROPERTY MANAGEMENT**

The Board recognizes that the education of children is dependent upon many factors, including a proper physical environment, which is safe, clean, attractive, pleasant and which functions smoothly.

The care, custody and safekeeping of all school district property is the general responsibility of the Maintenance and Operations Supervisor who reports to the Chief Operating Officer. It will be his/her responsibility to establish such procedures and employ such means that will ensure the proper maintenance and safekeeping of school district property.

Within the separate schools, the principal will be responsible for the proper care and maintenance of the building, equipment and grounds. The principal will establish the duties of custodial and maintenance employees assigned to his/her building in consultation with the Maintenance and Operations Supervisor.
