## EMPLOYMENT OF STUDENTS

Students' school responsibilities are to take precedence over non-school related jobs. However, students who need or desire to work part time while attending school will be encouraged to do so, provided their work commitments do not interfere with their achievement in school.

Any ~~child~~ **student** between the ages of 14 and 18 who has completed the work of the first eight grades may be excused from full-time attendance and may be permitted to enter proper employment or apprenticeship, by the written authority of the Board of Trustees excusing the ~~child~~ **student** from such attendance. The Board's written authority must state the reason(s) for such excuse.

No employer or other person shall employ or contract for the services or time of such ~~child~~ **student** until the ~~child~~ **student** presents a written permit from the attendance officer or Board of Trustees. The permit must be kept on file by the employer. Upon termination of employment, the permit must be returned by the employer to the Board of Trustees.
