STUDENT CONDUCT ON BUSES

Safety is of prime importance for our students as they wait for the bus and as we transport them to and from school and school-sponsored activities. Safety requires the cooperation of students, parents/legal guardians and school personnel. Parents/legal guardians should review and discuss the school bus rules with their ~~child~~ student in an effort to help him/her understand and assume responsibility for good conduct both at the bus stop and on the bus.

Students are charged with the responsibility of proper conduct while en-route to and from bus stops, at the bus stop, and while on the bus. Students will show respect for school personnel and respect other students. Failure to abide by the bus rules, show proper respect to others, and comply with requests of school personnel may result in a student being issued a Transportation Incident Report with subsequent discipline being administered by the administration of the school of attendance, up to and including denial of bus transportation for a period of one year (365 calendar days).
