BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On February 24 and 25, 2026, Levelland ISD had its District Vulnerability Assessment (DVA) conducted by Ms. Stacy Carter with the Texas School Safety Center. The DVA is a detailed, state-mandated evaluation conducted by the Texas Education Agency (TEA) Office of School Safety and Security to check physical and procedural security at public school districts.

TEA conducts a DVA for every school district at least once every four years on a random basis. Districts use the TEA's centralized digital system, called Sentinel, to upload requested safety data and documentation for review. Following the assessment, TEA generates a report reviewing observed best practices, suggesting improvements, and assigning required corrective actions with specific completion deadlines. Any corrective actions assigned to the District has been successfully completed.

Districts are required to report the results of the DVA to school board and then submit the agenda to TEA.
