Re: Lyon County School District Resolution in Support of iNVEST 2027

Recommendation

That the Board of Trustees adopt the Lyon County School District Resolution in Support of iNVEST 2027.

Background Information

The Nevada Association of School Superintendents (NASS) has developed an iNVEST document outlining legislative priorities intended to improve student achievement in Nevada. This year, NASS adopted a resolution in support of the iNVEST 2027 document and has requested that school boards throughout Nevada consider adopting a similar resolution. The Nevada Association of School Boards (NASB) has also adopted a resolution in support of the iNVEST 2027 priorities.

The iNVEST 2027 document identifies four key legislative priorities designed to strengthen Nevada's public education system and improve student achievement. First, NASS advocates for increasing and aligning education funding to ensure resources more accurately reflect student needs, including stabilizing district funding during enrollment fluctuations and supporting sustainable funding mechanisms. Second, NASS recommends refining Senate Bill 460 (2025) to preserve local control, streamline reporting requirements, strengthen accountability measures, and improve implementation of literacy-focused teacher preparation programs. Third, the document emphasizes strengthening early literacy supports through evidence-based reading instruction, early identification of reading deficiencies, family engagement, targeted interventions, and enhanced teacher preparation in the science of reading. Finally, NASS supports stabilizing, aligning, and expanding Pre-K funding structures to increase access to high-quality early childhood education, particularly in underserved rural and urban communities, while creating sustainable funding and workforce development pathways. Collectively, these priorities are intended to support student success, strengthen local school systems, and ensure Nevada remains committed to a future-ready education system.
