

**CONTRACTING FOR INSTRUCTION**

The Nye County School District may enter into contracts with other public school districts, public or private post-secondary institutions, approved trade or technical schools, or any other authorized state accrediting or licensing agency, to provide vocational education for District students, provided that the cost to the District will not exceed funds received by the State. The entity with which the District contracts will have adequate physical facilities and qualified instructional personnel and be able to provide instruction at the secondary level during the regular public school day.

District students will be taught in classes specifically designed or designated for public school students, but students from more than one district may be in the same class. The District may consent to a written request to combine secondary and post-secondary students in a public post-secondary institution when there are too few to justify a full class of secondary students.

When comprehensive special education services are required for students with educational handicaps, contracts or working arrangements with other organizations are authorized.
