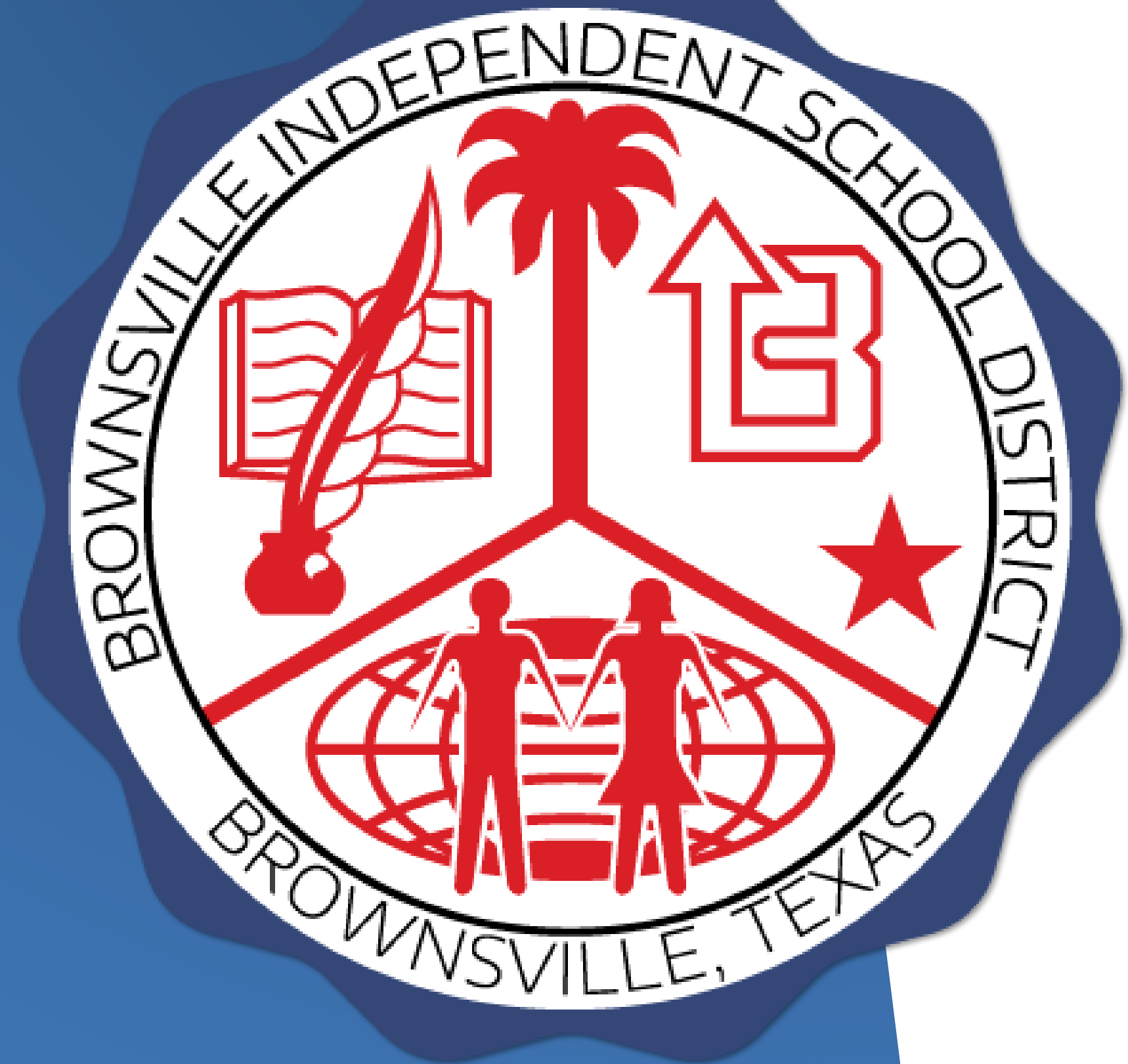

  - Ongoing coaching and mentoring programs

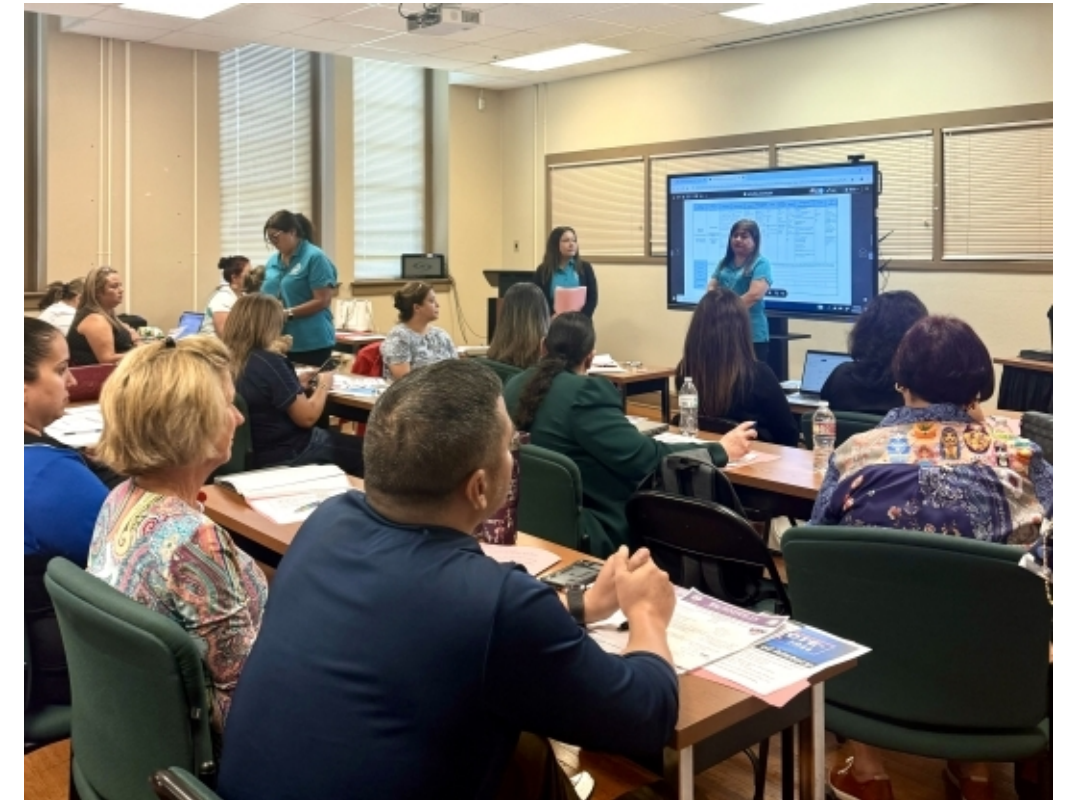
