Go Guardian LyOnline Test

- Started February 26
 - K-5 not notified
 - 6-8 not notified
 - 9th & 10th Grade Control Group
 - 11th & 12th Grade were not notified of use
- Pilot only addresses LyOnline use

Go Guardian Use

- Students added using Google Classroom
- Security Scenes applied to block usage of
 - Bots
 - Games
- Set calendars for 24-hour monitoring
 - Three Sessions per day, 8 hours each

Academic Dishonesty

- A student is identified by
 - Edgenuity attendance logs are reviewed
 - Speed Radar identifies students completing assignments too quickly
- Go Guardian Student Activity is reviewed
 - Student reports shows daily activities and websites
 - Only works for District Issued Chromebook

Outcome of Test

- 6-8th Grade,
 - 93 students with 536 Courses
 - 6 students were corrected within Go Guardian real-time
- 9th and 10th Grade, CONTROL GROUP, 3 students identified as cheating
 - 127 students with 775 Courses
 - 3 students on personal devices
- 11th Grade, 119 Students, 17 Students Identified as cheating
 - 119 students with 739 classes
 - 16 students using personal devices
- 12th Grade, 124 Students, 12 students Identified
 - 124 students with 757 classes
 - 10 students using personal devices
