Subject/Title for Agenda Posting: Approval of NWEA MAP-HMH Education Company to support instruction at Canutillo ISD's Elementary, Middle and High schools.

Agenda Summary:

Consider approval of the purchase of NWEA MAP Growth assessment software to support Canutillo ISD's instructional and accountability goals through a comprehensive, research-based student assessment system. NWEA MAP provides adaptive assessments in reading and mathematics that measure individual student growth over time, allowing teachers to identify specific learning gaps, differentiate instruction, and monitor progress throughout the school year.

The platform offers nationally normed data, predictive insights aligned to state assessments, and detailed reporting tools that support campus and district-level instructional planning. Benefits include targeted intervention support for struggling students, enrichment opportunities for advanced learners, real-time instructional decision-making, and improved alignment of classroom instruction to student needs. Additionally, NWEA MAP will support PLC conversations, intervention planning, MTSS processes, and district efforts to improve student achievement and accountability outcomes across all grade levels. This will replace Renaissance BOY, MOY, and EOY testing.

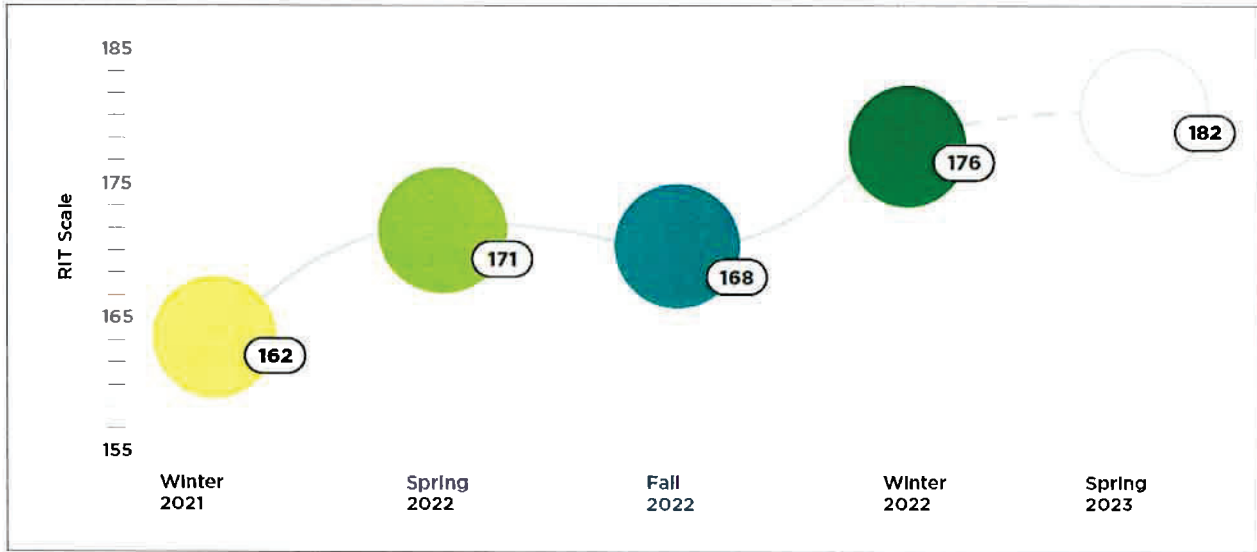
