NCSD school authorities are expected to maintain discipline; prevent the introduction of harmful, damaging and unlawful or deleterious items onto school premises; prevent school property from being used for illegal or illicit purposes; promote the safety and welfare of the student body and staff; and assure compliance with reasonable health and sanitary standards. To that end, school authorities, by law, have the inherent right and duty to search students, their personal possessions, their desks and lockers, and vehicles parked on school district property under appropriate circumstances.
