SUBJECT: Superintendent Report

What a fine day to be an American in Nye County.

Immediately following the Board Meeting on January 6, I departed for Laughlin, Nevada to attend the Annual Superintendent's Academy.

Tuesday, January 10, I brought my L-Team together to discuss SB404, AB580, and ACR10. I also sat in on part of the Website training that took place in the boardroom on the 10th and 11th.

On Thursday, January 12, 2006, I brought all the principals and supervisors in the district together for an Administrative Team meeting where we discussed testing, special education training, and a variety of site related topics.

Immediately after the Administrative Team meeting I traveled to Las Vegas and testified to the ACR 10 committee regarding Education funding adequacy issues in a rural school district based on cost, need, and available resource comparisons among and between other districts on items such as transportation, recruitment/retention, curriculum offerings, etc.

On Friday, January 13, I met with Congressman Gibbons to discuss a visitation of schools in Pahrump. On Friday evening, I attended the Pahrump Chamber of Commerce dinner. I sat with State Senator Bob Bears and his wife and we discussed the Nye County School District.

Tuesday, January 17, found the entire district office staff in the parking lot taking part in the official flag raising ceremony for our new flagpole. Captain Hernandez and his fine JROTC Color Guard conducted the ceremony. Kudos to the student JROTC Cadets.

On Wednesday, January 18, Congressman Gibbons joined me for a visit to various schools in Pahrump, concluding with a luncheon meeting with the Chamber of Commerce. We visited Pathways, Manse Elementary, and Hafen Elementary sites. The Principals briefed him on their schools; he visited classrooms, and met with kids and teachers.

After leaving Congressman Gibbons, I attended the County Commissioners meeting and commented on their proposition to amend the distance requirement for Class I liquor sales establishments from 1500 feet to 200 feet.

We have received confirmation from the Nevada Department of Education that two of our schools are eligible to participate in the Full Day Kindergarten Program, Manse and Amargosa.

Lastly, the Commission on Educational Excellence awarded Nye County School District \$852,297.75 for programs for innovation and prevention of remediation (see attached). There remains an opportunity to apply for additional monies not committed by the state department. We are certainly going to apply. Kudos to our principals, teachers, and district staff for their diligence in meeting the short time line, following directions, being creative, and keeping student achievement the focus of our district and school improvement plans.
