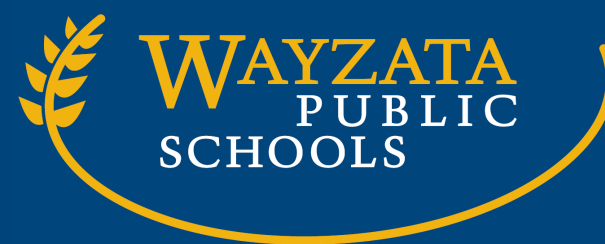

2021-22 School Year Financial Report Analysis

For the Month Ended August 31, 2021

Statement of Revenues Analysis

This analysis reflects revenue received by the month end noted above. Overall revenues are consistent with prior years with the exception of the Community Services Fund and Debt Service Fund. Community Services Fund revenue through August 31, 2021 was \$1,973,249 compared to \$712,119 the prior year. The favorable increase is due to less strict COVID-19 social distancing requirements than the prior year, yielding increased revenues from fee for service programs.

On June 28, 2021 the School Board approved the sale of bonds to refund the Series 2014A and Series 2014B General Obligation bonds. The District received the proceeds of the refunding bonds, the Series 2021A Taxable General Obligation School Building and Alternative Facilities Refunding Bonds, on July 22, 2021. The proceeds received by the District totaled \$137,249,726 and will be used to refund all maturities of the 2014A and 2014B bonds in February 2023, generating savings for taxpayers of the District in future years.

Statement of Expenditures Analysis

This analysis reflects actual expenditures and does not include outstanding encumbrances. Overall expenditures are comparable with prior years with the exception of the Debt Service Fund. As noted above, the District executed the sale of refunding bonds and received the proceeds of the sale in July. The District remitted the proceeds of the sale to the escrow agent responsible for making required principal and interest payments on the bonds. This transaction increased expenditures and other financing uses by the figure noted above. Additionally, the aforementioned transaction reduced the District's regularly scheduled August debt service payments. The escrow account established for the Series 2021A bond paid for a portion of the Series 2014A interest payment and all of the Series 2014B interest payment. The total amount paid by the escrow account in August was \$2,263,434.

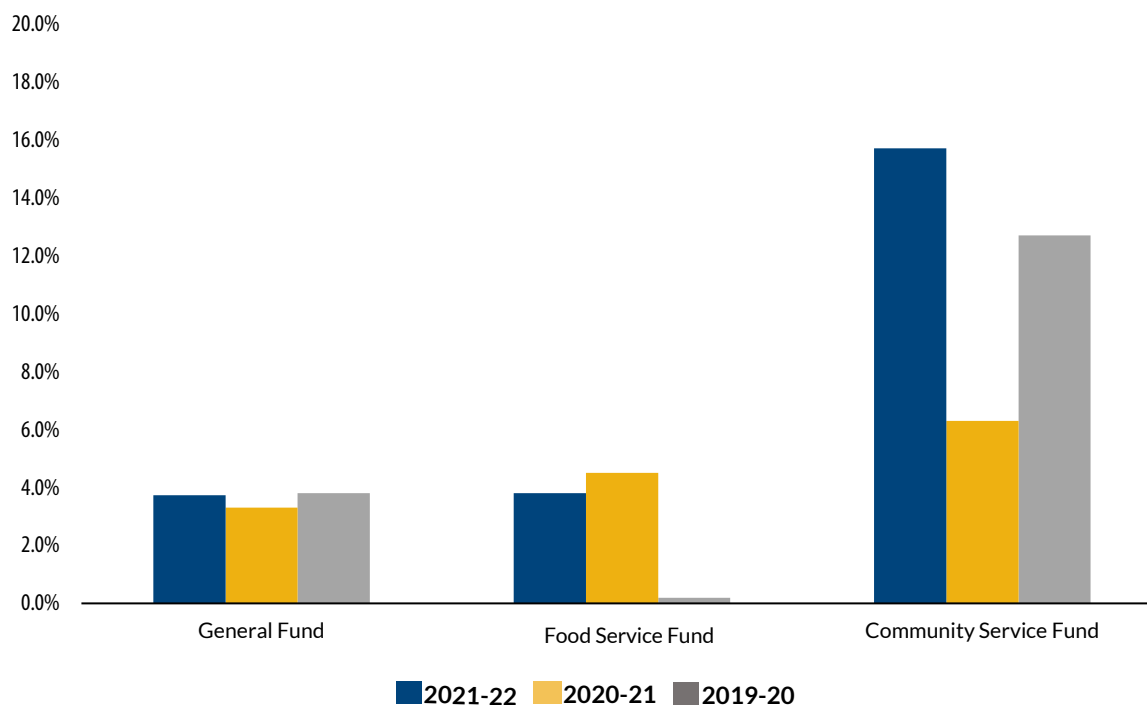

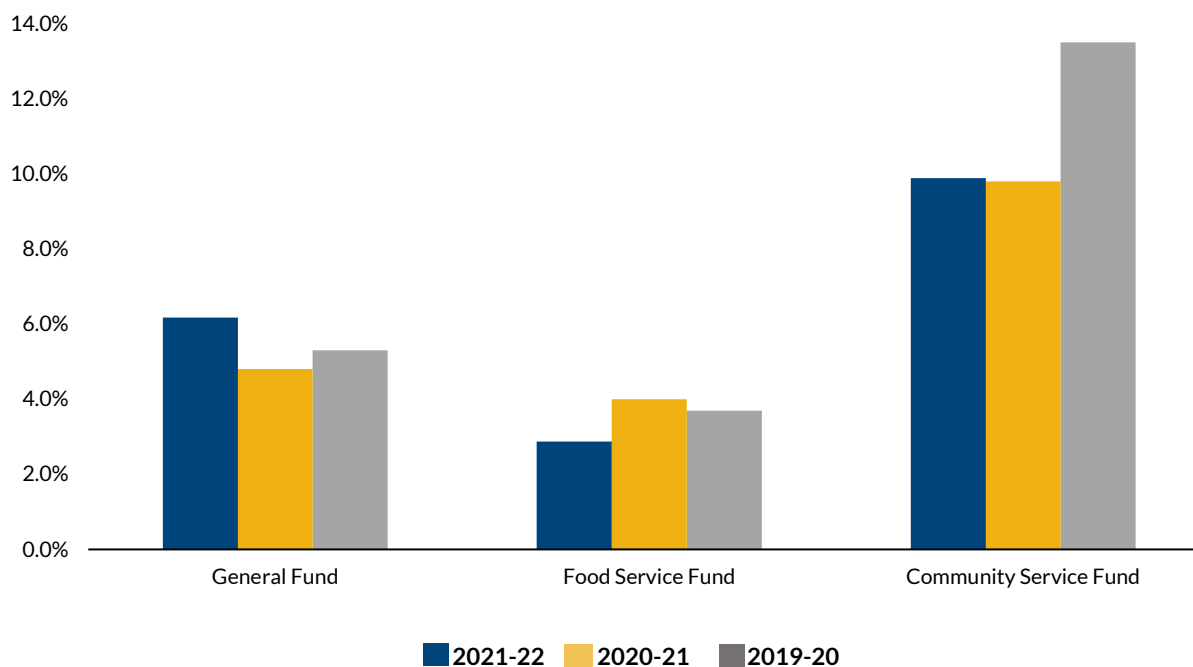

CDC: Guidance for COVID-19 Prevention in K-12 Schools Key Takeaways

- In-person instruction in the fall 2021 is a priority.
- Vaccination is currently the leading public health prevention strategy to end the COVID-19 pandemic.
- Masks should be worn indoors by all individuals regardless of vaccination status.
- CDC recommends schools maintain at least 3 feet of physical distance between students within classrooms, combined with indoor mask wearing by people who are not fully vaccinated, to reduce transmission risk.
- Students, teachers, and staff should stay home when they have signs of any infectious illness and be referred to their healthcare provider for testing and care.

- **When community rates of COVID-19 are high, especially with lower vaccination rates for those eligible for vaccination/many who are unable to be vaccinated.** there is an increased likelihood that SARS-CoV-2 will be introduced to, and potentially transmitted within, a school or ECE setting.
- Evidence to date suggests that when **prevention strategies are layered and implemented with fidelity, transmission within schools and ECE programs can be limited.**
- Have an infection rate that is comparable and, in some settings, higher, than adults.
- **Can transmit the virus to others even when they do not have symptoms** and/or have mild non-specific symptoms.
- **Compared to adults are more commonly asymptomatic or have mild, non-specific symptoms** (e.g., headache, sore throat).

Hennepin County and WPS---U of MN Wolfson Model 7 Day Running Total of Cases per 100,000 Residents

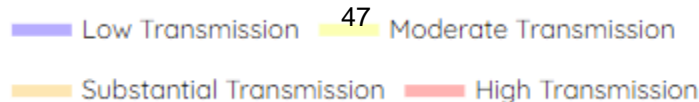
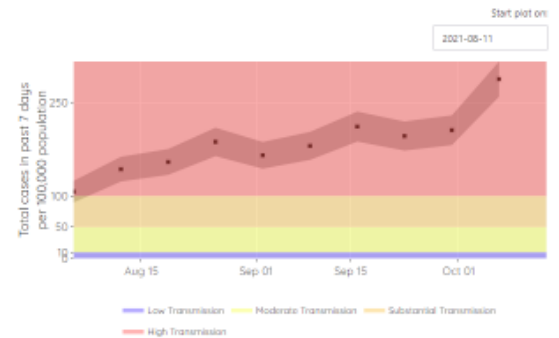
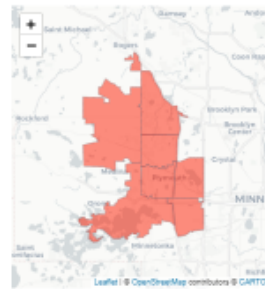
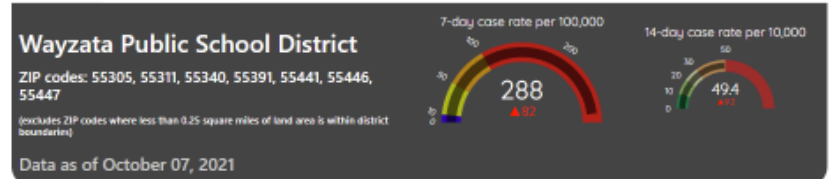

Mitigation Strategies

Indoor and Outdoor Quarantine Protocols

Indoors if Masked:

- Quarantines will not be mandated if all staff and students have been masked.
- Students who test positive for COVID-19 will continue to follow our current quarantine practices.
- If students are masked, and determined to be a close contact (within 3 feet for 15 minutes or longer), parents/guardians will be notified regarding exposure, but the students will not be required to quarantine. Parents may always choose to self-quarantine their student(s) when considered a close contact.

Indoors if Unmasked:

- Individuals who are indoors and unmasked who are determined to be a close contact (within 6 feet for 15 minutes or more) will need to quarantine (ex: lunchroom setting). Quarantine and isolation timelines requirements follow MDH guidelines.

Outdoors:

- No contact tracing will take place when students are outdoors.
- Should classrooms move outside for instructional purposes or snack, teachers should continue to distance students to the best of their ability, to limit possible exposure if students are unmasked.

Mitigation Strategies

Quarantine for Buses/Exemption Protocols/Isolation

Busing:

- Contact tracing will not take place on school buses, parents will be notified of potential exposure when a student on the bus tests positive for COVID-19.

Exemptions to Quarantine:

- Tested positive for COVID-19 in past 90 days
- Fully vaccinated (14 days from last dose in series)
- Students who have been over 3 feet from others students when both are fully masked

Isolation:

- When someone has tested positive, even if they are vaccinated, they must isolate for 10 full days from the time the symptoms began or from the time they tested positive (if they were asymptomatic)

Mitigation Strategies

Quarantine for Household/Non-Household Members

Household Members

- All unvaccinated persons who live in a household with someone who has tested positive must quarantine for 14 full days. If the person who tested positive is not able to isolate from other household members, the other persons must isolate with the person who tested positive and then must quarantine for an additional 14 days (possible total of 24 days if unable to separate).

All Other Non-Household Close Contacts

- All other non-household close contacts qualify for a shortened quarantine. If the unvaccinated close contact is able to show proof of a negative molecular or PCR test after day 3 from the last contact with the person who tested positive, they may return after 7 full days. Close contacts who decide not to test, or who are unable to show proof of a molecular or PCR test, may return after 10 full days of quarantine.

Mitigation Strategies

Testing

- The BinaxNow home tests are for symptomatic students and available from the school LSNs.
- Such tests are optional and offered as a convenience to families.
- WPS does not test students on site or endorse any specific test.
- We will continue to monitor available options for additional testing.
