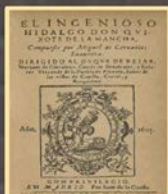

History of the famous Man of La Mancha

The staged, musical adaptation of *Man of La Mancha* was adapted from Dale Wasserman's 1959 teleplay *I, Don Quixote*. However, this work was also inspired by Miguel de Cervantes' seventeenth-century novel *Don Quixote*, which is considered to be the first modern novel made in European history.

The novel illustrates Spain's divergent worlds. Spain at the time was caught in the tumult of a new age, and Cervantes tried to create in *Don Quixote* a place to discuss human identity, morality, and art within this ever-shifting time. Although the renaissance gave rise to a new humanism in european literature, popular writing continued to be dominated by romances about knights in shining armor practicing the code of chivalry. Books of chivalry tended to contain melodramatic, fantastical stories about encounters with cruel giants, rescues of princesses in distress, and battles with evil enchanters—highly stylized accounts of shallow characters playing out age-old dramas.

The production itself made its world premiere in 1965 at the Goodspeed Opera House in East Haddam, Connecticut. This 1965 production won five Tony Awards, including Best Musical. The musical later traveled to New York to premiere at the ANTA Washington Square Theatre, and continued to travel making appearances at the Martin Beck Theatre (1968), the Eden Theatre (1971), and the Hellinger Theatre just before its end on Broadway. *Man of La Mancha* has been revived four times since on the Great White Way, most recently in a 2002 production led by Brian Stokes Mitchell.


Man of La Mancha has played around the world, with productions in Dutch, French, German, Hebrew, Irish, Japanese, Korean, Icelandic Gujarati, Uzbek, Bulgarian, Hungarian, Serbian, Slovenian, Swahili, Finnish, Ukrainian and nine different Spanish dialects of the Spanish language. Cast albums are available in multiple languages.

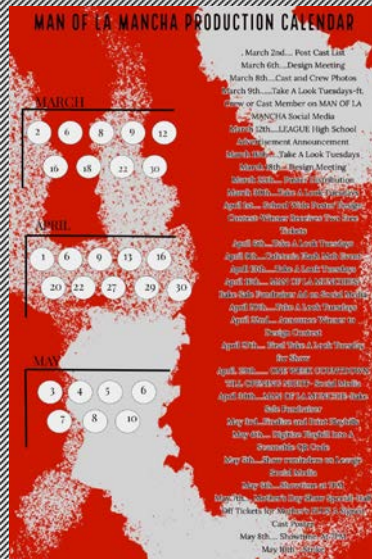

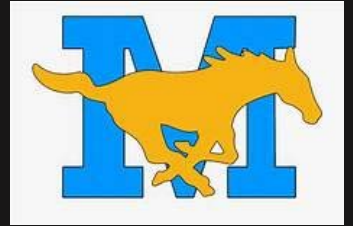

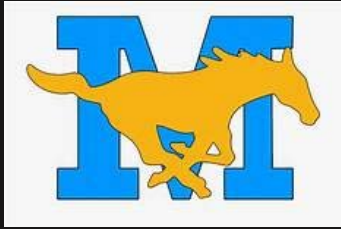

The Artist, Dore, was born on the 6th of January and very early on created pieces well matured beyond his years. He grew up to be an artist, printmaker, illustrator, comics artist, caricaturist, and sculptor.

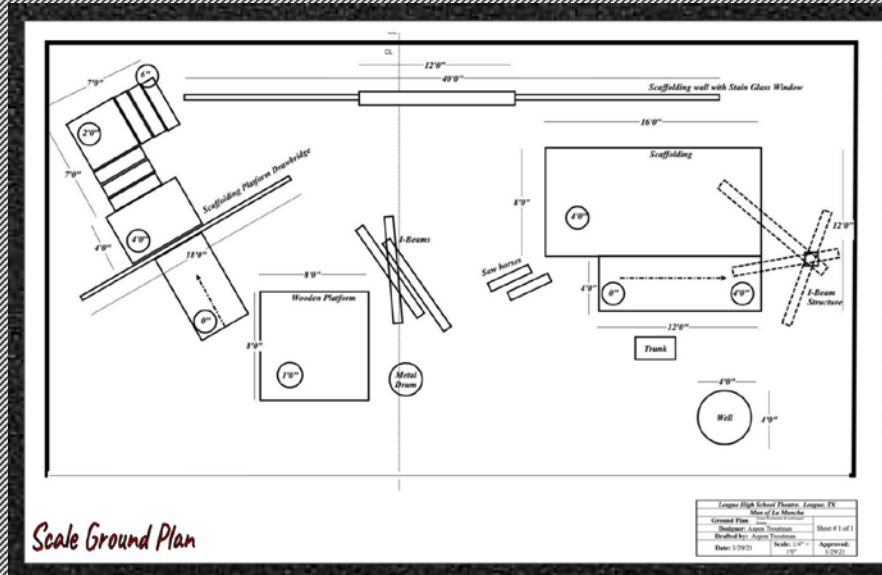

While many Quixote illustrations were light and carefree, he decided to take a bold risk and state what the true message of this play was: While they may imprison you, they cannot take away your imagination.
