**RESOLUTION CANVASSING RETURNS OF VOTES OF  
FRIDLEY INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 14  
GENERAL ELECTION HELD NOVEMBER 5, 2019**

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the School Board of Fridley Independent School District No. 14, State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. It is hereby found, determined and declared that the General Election of the voters of this school district held on November 3, 2020, was in all respects duly and legally held.

2. As specified in the attached Abstract and Return of Votes Cast, a total of 7,146 voters of the district voted at said General Election on the election of three (3) school board members for one (1) one (1) year vacancy on the board caused by resignation of a past Board Member. Votes cast for the office are as follows:

3. Ross Meisner, having received the highest number of votes, is elected to a one (1) year term.

4. As specified in the attached Abstract of Votes Cast a total of 7,761 voters of the school district voted at said Special Election to consider Ballot Question No. 1 as follows:

**SCHOOL DISTRICT BALLOT QUESTION 1  
RENEWAL OF EXPIRING CAPITAL PROJECT LEVY AUTHORIZATION**

The board of Independent School District No. 14 (Fridley Public Schools) has proposed to renew the school district’s existing capital project levy authorization of 5.47% times the net tax capacity of the school district. The money raised by the capital project levy authorization will be used to cover costs related to deferred maintenance and renovation projects at various sites and facilities, technology devices, and technology infrastructure. The proposed capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$1,016,000 for taxes payable in 2022, the first year it is to be levied, and would be authorized for ten years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$10,160,000. The projects to be funded have received a positive review and comment from the Commissioner of Education. Shall the renewal of the capital project levy authorization proposed by the board of Independent School District No. 14 be approved?
