The reality is that there are state-sponsored hacker groups that are targeting school districts and they have infinitely more resources than we ever will. As of the writing of this report we're going through the 2022 Department of Defense STIGs (Security Technical Implementation Guidance). This is a very tedious process where we examine tens of thousands of settings to ensure we're secure. We're also focusing on email security, ensuring that our domain has the latest security measures in place. We will also be rolling out new Cyber Security training for staff in the near future as well.

RE: Revenue Enhancement and Field Naming Rights

Board Members,

With the upcoming work of the athletic complex fundraising committee, we think it would benefit the district to craft an administrative rule or policy regarding large scale fundraising efforts and facility naming rights that may be used for the purpose of securing private funding to support the project.

The fundraising committee has secured samples of this language from other districts who have previous experience in these large-scale fundraising/sponsorship efforts. Below is a sample of language which could be considered for use by the district.

Revenue Enhancement

The district will consider opportunities for revenue enhancement such as sponsorships, grants, advertising, and fundraising. Any revenue enhancement opportunity pursued by the district must be consistent with the values and educational mission of the district. The Board has the exclusive discretion to determine whether to accept or decline any revenue enhancement opportunity. The factors to be considered by the Board include, but are not limited to:

1. The extent to which such revenue enhancement opportunity limits or restrains the district's discretion or its ability to pursue other opportunities.
2. The duration of the arrangement or agreement and the district's ability/discretion to terminate the arrangement/agreement.
3. The extent to which the revenue enhancement opportunity imposes any obligation on the district, either presently or in the future, financial, or otherwise and whether the opportunity is subject to conditions acceptable to the district.

4. The extent to which the revenue enhancement opportunity constitutes a conflict of interest or creates the appearance of or potential for a conflict of interest.
5. The extent to which the revenue enhancement opportunity interjects advertising or commercialism into the schools or classrooms.

The Board may designate an administrator or committee (or authorize the formation of a committee) to investigate, evaluate and/or consider potential revenue enhancement opportunities and to report its findings and recommendations to the Board.

Facility Naming Rights

The naming of any building or room or facility in the district must be approved by the Board of Cloquet Public Schools. Where naming rights are to be offered or implemented as a component of a fundraising drive for the construction of a new building or facility or the renovation of an existing building or facility, the Board may appoint a committee to develop recommendations and parameters for facilities naming rights and the recognition of donations.

The district recognizes that the naming rights of buildings and/or portions or components of buildings may present opportunities for revenue enhancement and fundraising. This includes district buildings, auditoriums, gymnasiums, fields/playgrounds, classrooms or similar rooms.

The Board reserves the right to decline to accept any donation conditioned on a naming right unacceptable to the district, as determined by members of the Board. Facilities will not be named for persons who are currently employed by the district or active in its operation or those who currently hold any public office.

Delegation of Responsibility

It shall be the responsibility of the administration to consult with potential donors and benefactors regarding potential gifts to the district or proposals to enhance revenue. Approval/acceptance of potential gifts or revenue enhancements are the exclusive authority of the Board. Any potential gifts or revenue enhancement, which have been determined to be consistent with the values and educational mission of the district by administration, shall be brought before the Board for consideration.

- 10 year athletic complex naming rights (branded signage at entrance)
- Windscreen logo on stadium & tennis court fencing





This Agreement is made as of the 12TH day of December, 2022, between THE COUNTY OF CARLTON, hereinafter “Grantor”, a body corporate and politic existing under the laws of the State of Minnesota, and the CLOQUET SCHOOL DISTRICT, hereinafter “Grantee”.

WHEREAS, state law establishes ambitious recycling goals for counties and mandates that counties plan for and ensure the provision of recycling services and opportunities; and

WHEREAS, Carlton County is committed to maintaining and expanding its already successful recycling and waste reduction programs; and

WHEREAS, Carlton County has funds for the purpose of expanding recycling and waste reduction efforts within Carlton County schools; and

WHEREAS, Carlton County has determined that the proposal (attached herein), submitted by Grantee promotes a successful recycling and waste reduction program; and;

WHEREAS, the Grantee will comply with all State and County permitting requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereby agree as follows:

3. Grantor has agreed to provide Grantee a grant in the sum of \$2,000 (two thousand dollars) subject to the following conditions:

a. Grantee shall incur eligible expenses as follows:

i. Collection materials for an effective recycling program must be purchased first. Remaining eligible purchases must aid in improved recycling and waste reduction efforts.

ii. Total grant funds shall be spent within six (6) months of the date of this agreement or by the last day of the school year, whichever occurs first.

b. The Grantee shall provide the Grantor a detailed final report on expenditures of grant funds six (6) months from the date of this

agreement or by the last day of the school year, whichever occurs first.

- c. The Grantee shall establish a “Green Team” to research and promote ‘green’ initiatives within their schools and provide Grantor with contact information for the team members.
- d. The Grantee shall make available all information necessary for tracking waste and recycling volumes and disposal costs for a minimum of six (6) months from the date of this agreement.
- e. The Grantee shall hold harmless and indemnify the Grantor and its officers, agents, and employees from any and all damages or financial obligations incurred by the Grantee in the grant project.

The Grantee warrants that such sums shall be used only for the purposes identified in subparagraph 3.a, above. Further, the Grantee shall not sell or dispose of any equipment purchased with the grant funds without prior written notification to, and approval from, the Grantor. The Grantor shall have the right to match any bonafide offer for the equipment at the fair market value minus the amount of the grant. Such right to purchase shall continue for five (5) years after the grant term or December 31, 2024.

- f. The provision of this grant does not constitute a joint venture or enterprise between the Grantee and the Grantor.
- g. Grantee's books, records, documents, papers, accounting procedures and practices, and other evidences relevant to this Agreement are subject to the examination, duplication, transcription and audit by the County and either the Legislative or State Auditor, pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 16C.05, subd. 5. Such evidences are also subject to review by the Comptroller General of the United States, or a duly authorized representative, if federal funds are used for any work under this Agreement. The Grantee agrees to maintain such evidences for a period of six (6) years from the date services or payment were last provided or made or longer if any audit in progress requires a longer retention period.
- h. The Grantee warrants that it has an affirmative action plan in place.
- i. The Grantee warrants that it shall comply with the terms of the grant application, attached as Exhibit A, and this grant application agreement.



