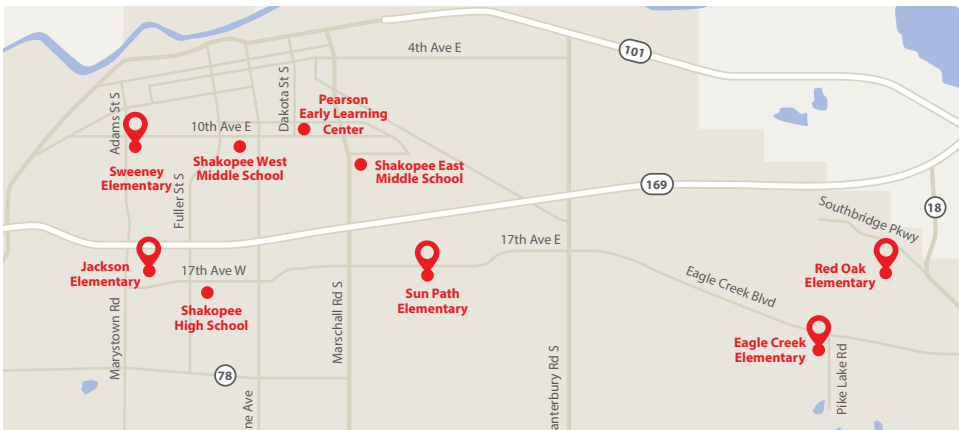

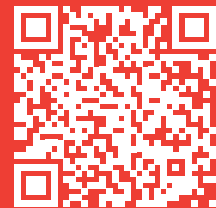
FREE TO ATTEND
