The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm.

President Mrkvicka noted that notice of the meeting was properly published in the Phonograph Herald, per policy.

President Mrkvicka noted that the Open Meetings Law is posted on the wall of the meeting room.

Vice President Scheer read the Americanism quote. Robert Winthrop in 1849 said, "Men, in a word, must necessarily be controlled, either by a power within them, or by a power without them;.... either by the Bible, or by the bayonet."
