Subject: 2020-21 Calendar Amendment

Executive Summary

On October 17, 2019, the Board of Education approved the calendar for the 2020-21 school year and then approved the revised calendar to include Election Day at the July 16th, 2020 Board of Education meeting.

ISBE has allocated 5 Remote Learning Planning days that districts can use during the 2020-21 school year. The District utilized two of these days at the beginning of the school year and one on Friday, October 16th, 2020 prior to the phasing in of the elementary Hybrid Return plan and one on Monday, January 4, 2021.

At this time administration is recommending shifting Friday, January 22nd, 2021 from a student attendance day to a Remote Planning Day. In discussions with various stakeholders; building administration, curriculum administration, and staff on various task forces; this is an ideal time for the utilization of RPD #5 as it would be located the Friday prior to the return of in person hybrid education. This day would allow for the district staff and administration to collaborate on students who would be changing classrooms, provide time to meet with new students as an introduction, prepare classrooms for student's physical return, etc.

Recommendation

Administration recommends that the Board of Education approve the amended 2020-21 school calendar as presented.
