There were no comments from the public.

Trustee Henderson motioned to adjourn; seconded by Symonds. A voice vote resulted in 4 ayes, 0 nays and 2 absent (Garcia, Lara).

Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes

7:00 p.m.

President Bednar was physically present as well as Secretary Henderson, Trustees Bedolla, Garcia and Symonds. Trustee Lara was absent. Chief Executive Officer Carole Medal and various members of the public and staff were also present.

President Bednar called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

There were no public comments.

Comments for the Good of the Organization were read.

Bedolla motioned to approve the August 12, 2025 board meeting minutes as presented; seconded by Garcia. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

Treasurer Bedolla moved to approve the payment of bills including the bills over \$10,000 as presented totaling \$370,078.37 and the revised list of bills to be paid prior to the next board meeting; seconded by Symonds. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

There was no correspondence.

CEO Report

The grand opening and ribbon-cutting ceremony for the Dinosaur Explorer exhibit will take place on September 22. Bids for the KidSpace phase 2 renovation project will be presented at the October board meeting. Construction is expected to begin in early December and conclude by early March 2026. A new small sorting machine is being considered for the South Elgin Branch. The Elgin Symphony Orchestra's piano trio will kick off the library's 20th concert season on September 28. Additionally, we are launching a new concert series at the South Elgin Branch on November 30.

Henderson motioned to approve the security report as presented; seconded by Symonds. Following a question regarding the theft, roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

Symonds motioned to approve the Fiscal Year 2025-2026 Operating Budget as presented; seconded by Garcia. CEO Medal gave a brief explanation of the changes to the operating budget. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

Henderson motioned to approve Ordinance 2025-9-1: Budget & Appropriation as presented; seconded by Symonds. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

Henderson motioned to approve Resolution 2025-9-A as presented; seconded by Garcia. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

Garcia motioned to approve a total of \$68,000.00 from the Capital Projects budget for upgrading two obsolete elevator door operators at the Main Library; seconded Symonds. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

Bedolla motioned to accept the proposal from Trane U.S. Inc. for \$62,521.00 to supply and install two OEM Supply and two OE Return VFD drives; seconded by Symonds. Brian Hoeg, Division Chief of Facilities & Building Operations, gave a brief explanation. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara).

CEO Medal explained that the Employee health insurance for 2025-2026 will remain with BlueCross BlueShield, offering three plan options for employees to choose from. The opt-out program will continue, and both dental and vision plans have been enhanced. Additionally, employees now have the option to purchase pet insurance—a new voluntary benefit, which employees will pay for themselves.

The 2025 Summer Reading Program was a success, with 6,285 participants completing the program an increase of 33.6% compared to last year.

Bednar motioned due to the resignation of Trustee Prochot, who is no longer a resident of the district, a vacancy exists on the Board. In accordance with Illinois State Statutes, I would like to nominate Ling Low to fill this vacancy until the next election; seconded by Symonds. Roll call resulted in 5 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Symonds), 0 nays, 1 absent (Lara). Trustee Bednar and Symons thanked all the candidates that applied.

Other

Trustee Bednar thanked the library for partnering with the U-46 Foundation on the Bedtime Story program. She also mentioned that during the Historic Elgin House Tour, it was clear how much the community loves the library and its exhibits.

Bedolla motioned to adjourn; seconded by Symonds. A voice vote resulted in 5 ayes.

Meeting adjourned at 7:39 p.m.

The Gail Borden Public Library District continued its commitment to community engagement and strategic improvements throughout September, successfully launching a major exhibit, celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month and achieving notable increases in key metrics.

Dino Discovery Delights

The new Dinosaur Explorer exhibit was successfully installed, launched and promoted, with **115 visitors** roaring with excitement at the Ribbon Cutting event.

The exhibit has already proven a strong programmatic impact, with a **31.2% increase in Main Library visitor count** between Sept. 18–30 compared to the same period in 2024.

Dinosaur-related book checkouts also saw a significant **increase of 68%** for the same period.

The exhibit garnered **immediate media attention**, featured in two major newspapers—the Daily Herald and The Courier-News—and a “must-see” amongst social media conversations.

The exhibit webpage has already recorded strong initial interest with **3,085 views**.

Initial data shows the powerful impact of hosting these fascinating exhibits, and solidifies the Library's role as a vital community hub for shared enjoyment and experience for people of all ages and backgrounds.



Dynamic Dinosaur Distribution

Staying on theme with the Dinosaur excitement, we rolled out a dino-riffic new, limited-edition Library card in September for Library Card Sign-Up Month. This card, along with additional random prizes, was given to new registrants.

The campaign resulted in a **26% increase in new Library cards** distributed in September 2025 compared to 2024.



Highlighting Hispanic Heritage

We celebrated the start of **Hispanic Heritage Month** with a series of successful, culturally inclusive programs that fostered community connections and celebrated resilience.



The **Cafecito entre Amigos** event, honoring National Grandparents Day, successfully brought together 55 older adults, families and caregivers in collaboration with community partners. We hosted 28 attendees for **Yoga with Rhythm**, which inspired two participants to sign up for library cards so they could continue using the HIVECLASS resource from home. A **Papel Picado workshop** engaged 28 attendees in traditional Mexican folk art. Highlighting the impact of Latinx leadership and community members, the **Our Heroes, Our Stories exhibit**, sponsored by the Illinois Legislative Latino Caucus Foundation, features ⁴¹eight Latinx local unsung heroes nominated by state legislators.

Engaging Everyone Everywhere

Our strategic programming, outreach and literacy efforts in September connected the Library with thousands of residents, showcasing our commitment to meeting the community—wherever they are.

Fostering Future Readers

Fall 1 Storytime sessions kicked off with **full registration lists and waitlists**, particularly for Toddler Time, demonstrating **high community demand** for our early literacy programs.

We structured Story Mix programs around The Basics principle of "Maximize Love, Manage Stress," ensuring caregivers and children **engage with thoughtfully-chosen books and songs to celebrate feelings** and routines.

Preparations are underway for the **Student Success Program** at Channing and Hillcrest Elementary Schools. This initiative is so important for our community, **exposing hundreds of students to the opportunity to check out library books** at regular Bookmobile visits throughout the school year.

Staff represented Gail Borden at two back-to-school nights at Prairie Knolls Middle School, interacting with **83 students, teachers, and family members** and proactively **providing crucial resources** to school teachers.



Dynamic Programming: Creativity, Culture and the Arts



The Renaissance Family Faire at the Rakow Branch, had a wide range of popular, hands-on activities, including leather stamping, henna art, a costume contest and live performances by the Brothers Dymm. These elements helped **foster creativity and family fun** for all 120 attendees.

The **20th season of the Sunday Afternoon Concert Series** began with a high-quality performance by the Elgin Symphony Orchestra Trio, continuing the legacy of CEO Carole Medal in bringing classical music to Library audiences. Music lovers were also treated to a performance by the Hix Brothers Ukulele Band.



We welcomed **73 students** to Studio 270 as part of class trips, and a new cohort of Youth Build Elgin received tours and engaged in digital media collaboration. This provided them with **access to valuable technology resources and skills**.



Elementary-aged children enjoyed **Homeschool Hangout**, apple-themed STEAM challenges and learning about folk art this month. Class visits of up to 60 kids learned about the library, explored the exhibit, and participated in "Book Tastings" in both English and Spanish.

Our Nature Rangers program continues to **inspire families to explore the wonder of the natural world** with a variety of activities such as Insect Investigation, Cloud Spotting and Moth Spotting.

Engaging Everyone Everywhere Continued...

Partnerships & Workforce Development



Our **outreach continues to flourish**, substantially **expanding Library reach**. Our ongoing collaboration with Hawthorne Nature Center connects us with new families and preschoolers. Our growing partnership with EPEL now places library staff directly in community playgroups at Zion Lutheran and Hanover Township, **building early literacy skills and fostering a love for reading at the earliest stages of development**.

The **Annual Community Job Fair** was a resounding success with **over 350 attendees**, demonstrating high demand for our services with customers lined up 45 minutes ahead of the event. This reinforces the **Library's role as a vital resource** for local career and business development.



Bookmobile staff participated in a **Touch-a-Truck** event with the Rotary Club of Elgin. The Book Bike successfully concluded its season at the Downtown Neighborhood Association Farmers Market, providing crafts and essential program information to the community.

Adult learning and engagement continued with programs like Recognizing the Latina Heritage of Illinois, the Kane County Expungement Clinic (providing **crucial legal assistance**), Medicare 101 and virtual author talks.

Key Projects & Planning

Final coordination efforts are nearing the finish line for the **2025 El Trote 5K Race** on October 18. This year's registrants have surpassed last year's count, showcasing **intense community interest** in the event.

We especially thank Jean Bednar and Elisa Lara for their time and effort with wonderful promo video(s). Along with being a major fundraising and cultural event, it is also creating new community connections in many ways.



Streamlining Service: Strengthening Staff Spaces

We focused on improvements to enhance the user experience and workspace functionality.



Drive-Up Return Window Improvements: Based on customer and staff feedback, we adjusted the user interface, timing and messaging to clarify when customers must reach out of their vehicles. These adjustments also aid in minimizing expected delays, simplify the experience, and ensures the library remains a welcoming and convenient place to visit.

Workspace Improvements and Furniture Refresh: The 1 East Workroom received a significant upgrade with gently used staff furniture from Mount Prospect Library. The project included deep carpet cleaning, installation, electricity and tech modifications, providing an overall improved, modern workspace for staff without incurring major costs.

Critical Care & Customer Convenience

Social Services assisted a **record number of 83 cases** this month! They provided **referrals for crucial needs**, including housing assistance, reconnecting water service, green card applications, passport renewals and soup kitchens.

Customer Relations is celebrating five years of offering the **License Plate Renewal Service**, having **processed over 6,400 stickers** since its beginning. Illinois residents can renew their license plate stickers and leave with the sticker the same day, adding another layer of convenience to their Library experience.



Acclaimed Accomplishments

Library staff continued to demonstrate leadership and expertise on a national scale. Tish Calhamer, Director of Community Engagement, was awarded a **prestigious grant from the American Library Association and the Yiddish Book Center**, which provides funding for future community book discussions and lectures and includes travel for specialized training.

Furthermore, Glenna Godinsky, Life Enrichment Manager, shared the Library's collaborative approach to community wellness by **presenting on dementia-friendly initiatives at the influential AgeGuide Aging Summit**.

Improving and Enhancing - Facilities & Features

We focused on key improvements for safety, aesthetics and functionality this month, including:



Fortifying Security & Staff Preparedness: The Security team is actively strengthening the safety protocols and ensuring staff are well-trained and prepared to handle complex situations.

- **Proactive Safety Training & Planning:** We continue security training for new staff, along with developing Emergency Procedure Manuals for all Branch staff (for when Security is not present), and updating essential safety maps for the South Elgin Branch.
- **Continuous Professional Development:** Security staff attended webinars on highly relevant, high-risk topics like substance abuse and gun violence, ensuring they are informed on current safety challenges.



Proactive Infrastructure Modernization and Preservation: We performed essential preventative maintenance by rebuilding a critical air handler motor ahead of winter, ensuring continuous heating, and replaced metal exterior edging with safer wood timbers at the Rakow Branch. Key upgrades include the successful installation of a new 100-inch smart TV and upgraded A/V equipment in Studio 270, a significant investment in digital creation resources. This ongoing strategic focus **ensures a safe, efficient and technologically advanced environment** for all staff and visitors.



Strategic Support for Major Initiatives: Through seamless cross-departmental collaboration and crucial electrical leg-work, we verified that the Main Branch's electrical system would meet the Dinosaur Explorer exhibit's specialized needs. This process led to the labeling of all outlets and breakers at Main, which will **significantly increase efficiency** for all future electrical work.

Our Security Training Coordinator is actively working with the El Troite 5k committee on numerous aspects of the race, ensuring a safe and successful cultural event.



Critical Technology Upgrades: We have made strong progress on migrating/enhancing our Network Security, guaranteeing the continuation of the Library's **robust cybersecurity**. Additionally, deploying Windows 11 23H2 and Microsoft Office 2024 updates ahead of deadline ensure continued security and functionality.
