April 14, 2026

7:00 p.m.

President Bednar was physically present as well as Secretary Henderson, Garcia and Symonds. Trustees Bedolla, Lara, and Low were absent. Chief Executive Officer Carole Medal, and various members of the public and staff were also present.

President Bednar called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

No objections were raised to Trustee Bedolla's electronic attendance for employment purposes or Trustee Low's electronic attendance due to illness.

Trustee Low joined the meeting electronically at 7:01 p.m.

Trustee Lara entered the meeting at 7:02 p.m.

There were no public comments.

Comments for the Good of the Organization were read.

President Bednar asked for a moment of silence for staff member JoBeth Silvey who recently passed away.

Lara motioned to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2026 Board Meeting; seconded by Garcia. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 6 ayes (Bednar, Garcia, Henderson, Lara, Low, Symonds), 0 nays and 1 absent (Bedolla).

Trustee Bedolla joined the meeting electronically at 7:06 p.m.

Treasurer Bedolla moved to approve the payment of bills including the bills over \$10,000 as presented totaling \$849,632.10 and the revised list of bills to be paid prior to the next board meeting; seconded by Lara. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 7 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Lara, Low, Symonds), 0 nays.

There was no correspondence.

Foundation

The Foundation voted to appoint Ursela Wilson as a new board member and reported a highly successful book sale, generating more than \$26,000—the second-highest total in its history. They approved sponsoring a YWCA Leader Luncheon table. A Special Donor Recognition Luncheon will be held on Wednesday, May 27, in the Meadows Community Room, honoring the Hoffers,

Rakows and Andersons for their generosity, there is no cost for attendees. The Foundation will also sponsor a ticketed play “Aging with Grace and Humor” in June. Additionally, the Foundation ratified an email vote to become a lead sponsor for the Literacy Connection’s Poetry Festival. The next Foundation meeting is June 2.

CEO Report

The KidSpace Reimagined grand opening attracted approximately 1,300 attendees. Staff have noticed parents are more engaged with their children in the new space. This month included five days of attendance exceeding 2,000 visitors, the most since 2019. The media bank is officially closed at Main and DVDs are now available on carts until the new shelves are installed. The License Plate Sticker Renewal service is temporarily unavailable as we transition to a new vendor. The library received an award from the City of Elgin Police Department recognizing the outstanding contribution, time and talent at community events throughout the year. The Illinois Library Association’s March 2026 issue of *ILA Reporter* highlighted two improvement projects at the Gail Borden Public Library District: The KidSpace Reimagined project and the South Elgin Branch expansion. The Meadows Community Room AV upgrades have been completed. Most of the work for the EV chargers is done at Main and Rakow. A grant will be submitted to the Illinois State Library for the Smart Security, Safe Library: Leveraging AI Analytics for Outdoor Protection project.

Garcia motioned to approve the Security report; seconded by Henderson. CEO Medal commented that a part time security guard has been hired for the South Elgin Branch. There was no discussion. Roll call resulted in 7 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Lara, Low, Symonds), 0 nays.

Presentation: Family Place Library

Kate Boucher, Director of KidSpace gave a presentation on Gail Borden Public Library’s Family Place Library designation, including its focus on early childhood development, caregiver engagement, staff training, and play-based programming. She noted that the designation only applies to the Main library.

Symonds motioned to approve the Rose Paving proposal in the amount of \$21,000.00; seconded by Henderson. Following a short discussion regarding signage and parking lot availability on Memorial Day, roll call resulted in 7 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Lara, Low, Symonds), 0 nays.

Garcia motioned to approve Engberg Anderson architectural and engineering fee not to exceed \$43,000; seconded by Symonds. CEO Medal explained the request is for the remaining work in KidSpace (Story Room and outdoor patios), increasing the size of the IT switch room, and various upgrades to the Rakow Branch and asked that the not to exceed amount be changed to \$50,000. Garcia amended her motion to approve the Engberg Anderson Architectural and engineering fee not to exceed \$50,000. Symonds seconded the amended motion. Roll call resulted in 7 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Lara, Low, Symonds), 0 nays.

Henderson motioned to approve Personnel Policy 7.30 Travel/Mileage and other expense reimbursements changes as presented; seconded by Lara. CEO Medal explained this policy is for

staff reimbursement only. Roll call resulted in 7 ayes (Bednar, Bedolla, Garcia, Henderson, Lara, Low, Symonds), 0 nays.

Other

Trustee Garcia congratulated Trustee Henderson on her YWCA nomination.

Symonds motioned to adjourn; seconded by Lara. A voice vote resulted in no nays.

Meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.

A primary objective this month has been the strategic development and launch of this year's Summer Reading Challenge, **intentionally designed to drive literacy across all ages and demographics.**

The inspiring 2026 reading challenge promotional video was developed and finalized. The campaign emphasizes that reading is a multi-generational journey, essential for growth and development for all, while also framing the library as a shared space for families to grow together.

We developed tiered reading logs tailored to children, teens and adults. As we gear up for the **May 29 Kickoff event**, a comprehensive suite of physical and digital assets were created and have begun circulating to inspire and excite readers of all backgrounds.

National Library Week: Engagement & Excellence

National Library Week served as a premier opportunity to showcase the Library's value as a trusted public resource and a destination for family-centered discovery.

The Library was featured in a live morning news segment on CBS Chicago with anchor, Jackie Kostek! This high-profile placement extended our reach far beyond the Library District, garnering a wave of positive community feedback and further solidifying our standing as a leading institution.

The segment's popularity continued online, generating substantial digital interaction.

Our popular children's book character-themed scavenger hunt turned Library visits at all three buildings into an interactive learning adventure throughout National Library Week. This initiative was an exciting success, drawing nearly **400 participants** to complete the hunt, discover new areas of the Library and share in the excitement of beloved children's literature.



Key Projects

The "KidSpace Effect" on Literacy - The reimagined KidSpace has successfully transitioned from its grand opening to a functional engine for community literacy. By enhancing access and offerings, and modernizing the collection layout, we have created an environment that is now a regional benchmark, frequently cited by visitors as the **premier destination and learning hub for families**.

The Creation Station has re-emerged as an exciting hub for collaborative, STEAM-based play. This space bridges the gap between formal education and leisure, providing a high-quality, cost-free environment where caregivers and children engage in side-by-side learning.

Staff have observed consistent **intergenerational bonding** through curated daily activities like "Fun Fridays" and daily tabletop activities like Minecraft blocks and LEGO bricks. The success was amplified this month by the return of **U-46 class visits, reintegrating entire grade levels back into the Library's educational ecosystem**.

One Year of "The Basics" Partnership - April marked the one-year anniversary of our partnership with **The Basics of Greater Elgin (EPEL)**. As a "first implementer" of this initiative, the Library has successfully integrated these science-based developmental principles into our infrastructure, ensuring that our facilities serve as active tools for brain development for children ages 0-5.

Purposeful Environments:

A **dedicated Basics Engagement Station** within KidSpace and the launch of "Basics Kits," which allow caregivers to take these vital developmental tools home for continued learning.

Implementation at the Branches, including a **new sensory space for infants and updated youth play areas** to align with specific literacy outcomes, ensuring all our facilities serve a developmental purpose.



This strategic focus has solidified our reputation as a regional benchmark. Families who frequent libraries across the area have cited Gail Borden as the "best" in the region, specifically praising the intentionality of our toys, programs and the "bright, beautiful and open" atmosphere.

Visual Storytelling & Impactful Exhibits

Our exhibit strategy this month focused on Elgin's unique cultural and historical identity while preparing for a major interactive seasonal launch.

Cultural & Historic Preservation - In collaboration with Hispanic Services, we debuted the Spring Fiestas art display to celebrate our diverse community and talented local artists.



Simultaneously, we coordinated May's installation of the Elgin History Museum's **Dairies to Prairies** display and curated a **local historic architecture exhibit** for Preservation Month featuring artifacts from the Peaslee House and local watercolors. These two displays connect residents with Elgin's rich dairy history and architectural legacy.

Enhancing Summer Engagements - Final preparations are underway for the **Earth Matters exhibition**, opening May 18. A key element we are excited to debut will be our in-house developed "Draw to Life" game, where children's hand-drawn flowers will bloom to life in a digital garden. This high-tech interactive perfectly fits with the exhibit's environmental message and the Plant a Seed – Read! summer reading theme.



Visual Landmarks - To mark America's historic 250th Anniversary, commemorative flags were installed across all three branch flagpoles.

Additionally, the South Elgin Branch now features a **custom cityscape mural featuring popular local landmarks**, reinforcing community pride for our South Elgin Branch community.



Engaging Everyone Everywhere

The Library as Civic Convener - We moved beyond traditional programming by hosting the **People in Crisis Discussion** (with more than 15 organizations including PADS and EPD). By serving as a vital, neutral table for difficult local conversations, we **facilitated essential dialogue** between law enforcement, social service providers, and city advocates to help streamline rapid-response protocols and improve city-wide safety.

Cultural Identity & Artistic Expression - Through live painting and the Circle of Latino Artists display, we transformed the Library into a gallery that mirrors our community's diverse creative voices.

Supported by the National Endowment for the Arts, our Café, Conchas y Mango Street program paired Sandra Cisneros' literature with a live Ballet 5:8 performance. This multi-sensory experience provided attendees with both physical books and the experience of professional ballet.



Mobile Outreach & Neighborhood Equity -

We successfully reached over **1,500 visitors**, embedding high-tech resources into popular community events, including EPD's Color Explosion Egg Hunt and Autism Awareness night, along with local STEAM nights.

The Bookmobile has resumed service at **37 regular locations**. ReaderShip and elementary staff conducted targeted **outreach at Fox Meadow and Kenyon Woods Middle School** for National Library Outreach Day.

By prioritizing mobile outreach and neighborhood equity, we ensure that we are consistently providing vital resources to those who face mobility barriers.

Engaging Everyone Everywhere Continued...

Volunteer Recognition & Community Gratitude - April served as a month of deep appreciation, highlighted by our Volunteer Appreciation Lunch and a dedicated Hispanic Services Volunteer Celebration. By honoring our volunteers through these events, we **recognize the immeasurable impact of volunteer contributions.**



We provided students with diverse learning needs critical vocational mentorship and mock interview experience through our partnership with **Judson University's RISE Program**. This symbiotic relationship provides the Library with **16 hours of weekly support** while **building foundational professional confidence for the students.**

Crisis Intervention & Housing Stability - The Social Services team demonstrated their **life-saving impact** by successfully averting the homelessness of a senior resident. Facing a 30-day eviction notice due to deteriorating apartment conditions, staff swiftly assisted with coordination between property management and municipal aid. This example reinforces the **Library's critical role as a navigator and collaborator in Elgin's social safety net, ensuring our most vulnerable neighbors remain safely housed.**

Building the Future: Early Literacy & STEM Exploration -

- **Foundational & Inclusive Literacy:** We offered early childhood programs, including **Baby and Me** and **Pajamas and Paws**, that functioned as literacy workshops to equip caregivers with play-based tools for brain development. This commitment to inclusivity extended to our **YWCA Family Literacy partnership**, where bilingual storytimes and creative stations removed financial barriers, providing families with the essential tools needed for academic success.

- **Bridging the Tech Gap for Youth:** Through **Intro to Ozobots** and targeted **STEM Enrichment**, we provided engaging opportunities for youth to interact with emerging technology. By providing hands-on access to tech, the Library serves as a vital hub where children can develop necessary digital skills.

- **Cultivating Teen Agency & Professionalism:** A massive outreach effort to over **600 students** at Kenyon Woods Middle School showed instantaneous impact, with many students returning the next day to mentor peers in our makerspaces. This sense of ownership was mirrored in the **Digital Media Lab**, which saw high activity, serving as a critical resource for podcasting, audio recording and video post-production. This equipment ensures that economic barriers do not hinder our community's creative and professional output.



Empowering Community Belonging - Our meeting rooms have become a primary driver for new engagement, with **44 external groups and 417 neighbors** utilizing these spaces in April to plan, learn and organize. This high demand—highlighted by a single weekend where **63 teens** utilized Studio 270 for collaborative projects—is actively transforming the community's perception of the Library from a "building for books" into an essential professional and social resource for all residents.

Legacy and Learning: Local History & National Milestones - As we continue celebrating America's 250th Anniversary, history and local heritage programs are proving to be successful and engaging for residents. A high-interest Declaration of Independence program was described by attendees as "awesome and very informative."

Additional adult program opportunities ranged from the Hollis Prize Winner's Recital and grant education from our own local grant expert, Miriam Lytle, to virtual and hybrid programs on America 250, The Titanic, Chicago's coast and Kane County forest preserve history.



Operational Excellence & Enhancements



Technological Refinement - Strategic technical adjustments this month focused on streamlining our high-demand meeting and recording spaces. We fine-tuned the Meadows Room AV system and resolved network conflicts, **optimizing our livestreaming and recording capabilities** for both public and staff use.



Site Stewardship & Accessibility - Seasonal transitions focuses on preserving our public assets and enhancing the aesthetic experience for visitors.

Improved Navigation: Staff installed **"Open/Close" signage** at the Rakow Branch to provide immediate clarity for visitors and enhance site accessibility.

Grounds & Conservation: We conducted parking lot repairs and power washing, improving safety and curb appeal. Additionally, we successfully de-winterized and repaired the Main Library irrigation system, replacing damaged components to **ensure efficient water usage and a healthy landscape** for the spring season.



Infrastructure Modernization & Efficiency - We continue to invest in high-performance building systems to ensure environmental comfort, safety and durability.

HVAC Optimization: We upgraded Variable Frequency Drives (VFDs) on Main Library air handlers to improve energy **efficiency**, system reliability and consistent indoor climate control.

Security & Safety Upgrades: Replaced aging security hardware, including the original staff entrance alarm pad and faulty sensors, to ensure **uninterrupted building monitoring**.

Preventative Care: We completed annual fire and sprinkler inspections and executed essential roof repairs across the district to **extend facility lifespans** and prevent possible damage.

Educational Exploration



Staff attended several offerings for continuing education, learning critical information and new tools to propel our future plans for serving the community.

Public Library Association (PLA) -

Our leadership attendees engaged in high-level strategic sessions, including an invitation-only Family Place Seminar and workshops on Customer Relationship Management (CRM). These insights ensure our management practices remain resilient and our services remain accessible and responsive to current library trends.

Innovative Users Group (IUG) Chicago: Technical Systems & AI -

Executive Summary: Hold Pickup Locker Recommendation

The committee, led by Robert Moffett (Division Chief of Access Services) and comprised of key leadership from Community Services, Branch Services, Technical Services, and Library Applications, has completed an extensive evaluation of hold pickup locker solutions.

Evaluation Process

The team researched three primary vendors based on existing institutional familiarity:

- D-Tech (Murphy Security Solutions)
- Bibliotheca
- Lyngsoe

The vetting process included direct product demonstrations and peer-to-peer consultations with several library systems, including Aurora Public Library, Arlington Heights Memorial Library, Boulder Public Library District, and Fountaindale Public Library. These conversations provided critical insights into real-world reliability, support quality, and user experience.

Key Findings & Unanimous Recommendation

After a thorough analysis of vendor support and technical capabilities, the committee unanimously recommends the Lyngsoe locker system.

While all vendors presented viable options, Lyngsoe distinguished itself through a proven track record of reliable customer service and three specific technical advantages:

- **User Flexibility:** It is the only system that allows patrons to selectively leave behind items at the locker if they change their minds, ensuring a better customer experience.
- **Operational Continuity:** The unit remains fully functional for pickups even during an internet service disruption, preventing service gaps.
- **Staff Efficiency:** The loading process is significantly more streamlined. Unlike competing models that require secondary administrative software to assign bins, Lyngsoe allows staff to simply scan barcodes or RFID tags directly at the unit.

Final Conclusion

Given the long-standing successful history with Lyngsoe and the clear operational efficiencies of their locker hardware, the committee recommends moving forward with the purchase of the Lyngsoe system at the Rakow Branch to enhance our library's holds delivery service for a total cost of \$32,548.15, which includes 25 lockers and five years of support. In addition, we recommend purchasing a second locker for the South Elgin Branch. Total cost for both lockers & maintenance: \$65,096.30. Costs for equipment will be included in the FY26-27 budget.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: Lyngsoe Sorting System – South Elgin Branch

BACKGROUND:

Our journey with Lyngsoe Systems began in 2012, and since that time, we have installed the original sorter at Main, upgraded that original system and installed a sorting system at the Rakow Branch.

When the expansion construction on the South Elgin Branch began, a sorting system did not seem to fit the plan, since a drive-up location would not be available for our public. Instead, a manual book drop was installed inside the building, near the main entrance doors. As traffic at the South Elgin Branch has continued to increase, the staff time to manually check in materials has grown, and the request for a sorting system from the public has driven us to revisit the sorter idea.

We first looked at the options for a sorting system at the South Elgin Branch in August 2025. Both Bibliotheca and Lyngsoe presented options and preliminary pricing, but we were not ready at that time to commit to move forward. Since that time, Robert Moffitt has been working with Lyngsoe for the purchase of a locker system for the Rakow Branch. Using this purchase as leverage with Lyngsoe, they dropped their pricing for the sorting system by several thousand dollars. Both Bibliotheca and Lyngsoe have been long-time partners of Gail Borden Public Library and have brought forward several products that have been beneficial. Lyngsoe, however, continue to offer us aggressive pricing, superior service and it only makes sense to use Lyngsoe equipment at South Elgin to remain consistent with the parts we maintain onsite, as well as the familiarity of staff with their hardware and software.

As with the locker system, the lead time for getting the sorting system is 6 months. Gail Borden would like to take advantage of the pricing decrease, as well as the synergies of moving ahead with both projects at the same time. The total pricing for this sorting system is \$43,494.00, which we will include in the FY 2026-2027 budget – as it was not budgeted for this year. Right now, Lyngsoe requires a 20% downpayment of \$8,699.00 upon receipt of the order. This amount will be taken from the FY 2025-2026 operating budget, so we can move forward with this project. In addition to the sorter costs, there will be some minor construction (moving the induction point from the manual book drop and electrical additions) and this is already on the radar for SMC Construction. We do not have a total cost for this work, but it should not be extensive.

The purchase of the sorting system will include 12 months of standard maintenance. There will be an additional cost for added years of maintenance (TBD).

RECOMMENDATION:

It is my recommendation, as well as the Library Cabinet, to purchase a Lyngsoe sorting system for \$43,494.00. In addition, we are seeking Library Board approval of the 20% downpayment required (\$8,699.00) to begin this project. The 20% downpayment will be made from the FY 2025-2026 budget, and the remaining \$34,795.00 will be included in the FY 2026-2027 operating budget.
