- X. DISTRICT EMPLOYEES AND OFFICERS
 - A. Deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, of a public officer or employee, including board member resignations, terms and resulting appointments, pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code Section 551.074
 - B. Deliberation Regarding Security Devices or Security Audits, pursuant to Tex. Gov't Code Section 551.076.
