They will also assess equipment maintenance, cleaning areas, custodial handbooks and training materials for new employees. Total cost for the services are \$4,500.

SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT AND RELEASE

This Settlement Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into between the Hazel Park Schools ("District"), and the Hazel Park Education Association, MEA/NEA ("Association").

Recitals

1. The Association filed an unfair labor practice charge on October 27, 2022, MERC Case No. 22-J-1980-CE, challenging the Board's actions and those of its agents.
2. The District and the Association have agreed that it is in their mutual and respective best interests to formulate, agree upon, and implement an acceptable and amicable resolution of MERC Case No. 22-J-1980-CE in the interest of promoting harmonious labor relations and in avoiding further litigation.
3. The District and the Association desire to enter into this Agreement to memorialize their agreement.
4. The District and the Association have agreed to adjust, compromise, and settle permanently all controversies, claims, disputes, and differences existing between them arising from the unfair labor practice allegations.

Agreement

In consideration of their mutual covenants and undertakings as stated below, the sufficiency of which is acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Association will withdraw with prejudice MERC Case No. 22-J-1980-CE.
2. The District shall pay the stated amounts to each member listed on Attachment A. The payments shall be made in a lump sum, and will be paid not later than the end of the first full pay period following execution of this Agreement. The Parties have made a good faith effort to include everyone appropriate on this list. If it is determined later that the Parties have made a mistake, they will work together to remedy the situation.
3. With respect to the issue of the HPEA monitoring the District's action in awarding outside experience credit and placement on the proper lane in the future, the District agrees that each time an HPEA bargaining unit member is hired, the District's actual working documents reflecting such action will be copied and placed in a folder for

the HPEA to be reviewed at its convenience. A copy of those working documents in an actual case is attached as Attachment B.

4. The Parties' execution of this Settlement Agreement and Release does not represent, nor shall it be construed as, an admission of any nature about any matter arising from the unfair labor practice allegations.

5. In consideration of the terms of this Settlement Agreement and Release, the Association agrees to discharge and release the District (including individual Board members, administrators, employees, and agents) from all claims, complaints, charges, demands, grievances, claims for arbitration, and other causes of action (pending or contemplated) of any kind which the Association currently has or may claim to have arising out of the step placement of current bargaining unit members at the time of their initial hire. The District and the Association agree that this Settlement Agreement and Release is a full and final accord and satisfaction between and among them as to all such claims.

6. This Settlement Agreement and Release establishes no precedent or past practice by and between the Employer and the Association and constitutes neither a breach of nor a modification of the collective bargaining agreement between the Employer and the Association.

The Parties have caused this Settlement Agreement to be executed on the date indicated below their signatures.

In an effort to increase access and the opportunity to graduate from high school with college credit and/ a degree, we are seeking to apply for an Early Middle College (EMC).

An Early Middle College is a five-year program of study for high school students. The EMC concept will allow students to network with a cohort of students as they grow their college and career readiness skills during their time in the EMC. Students enrolled can earn up to 60 college credits, an associate's degree, professional certification, and/or access to apprenticeship programs that can lead to career placement. Hazel Park is seeking to apply for an Early Middle College Program, which is a high school program designed to serve less than 100% of the high school population. This program will be offered to all 9-12 Hazel Park students.

If the Early Middle College application is approved by the Michigan Department of Education (MDE), the goal is to partner with Oakland Community College for students to earn college credits and/or certifications. Students enrolled in the Early Middle College program would have the opportunity to enroll and gain access to learning programs such as an Associate of General Studies or Technical Studies that may include the Firefighter's Academy, Police Academy, and other areas of concentration.

We are targeting to open the EMC by enrolling at least 10 students starting in 11th grade. Opening an EMC will come with an upfront cost that would include tuition, course fees and supplies, and more per student. The charts below detail what a program of study could look like and the cost per student for that program of study.

SAMPLE STUDENT PROGRAM OF STUDY

The following is a sample Program of Study for a student working to earn a Technical Sciences degree and FireFighter certification at Oakland Community College. Please keep in mind that the certification is only an option. A student could continue their studies by simply completing the Technical Sciences Degree. However, this degree pathway complements our current students enrolled in the Fire Academy. For that reason, I provided this sample.

With the departure of Mr. Brown from the residence at Camp Hazelwood, we no longer have an individual that is dedicated to maintaining the property. In order to maintain the grounds we recommended the following options for the work;

1. Have District staff perform the work which would be cutting and maintaining the grounds which would require them driving up one day a week depending on the staff sent.
2. Hire an outside company to perform the maintenance local to the campgrounds
3. Seek out another individual to live on the grounds under an employment agreement that would exchange residing on the property for maintaining the grounds.

The Committee recommended that the third option be presented to the Board for approval. There has been a significant amount of funding spent to revitalize Camp Hazelwood and the first two options do not maintain a presence on site throughout the days the property is not in use.

We are presenting this information as part of the expulsion process in accordance with the policy 5610:
The Superintendent will exercise discretion over whether or not to suspend or expel a student for persistent disobedience or gross misconduct. In exercising that discretion for a suspension of more than ten (10) days or expulsion, there is a rebuttable presumption that a suspension or expulsion is not justified unless the Superintendent can demonstrate that it considered each of the factors listed above. For a suspension of ten (10) days or fewer, there is no rebuttable presumption, but the Superintendent will still consider these factors in making the determination.

Students are afforded due process per policy 5610:
The Board recognizes exclusion from the educational programs of the District, whether by suspension or expulsion, is the most severe sanction that can be imposed on a student and is one that cannot be imposed without appropriate due process, since exclusion deprives a child of the right to an education. The Board also recognizes that it may be necessary for a teacher to remove a student from class for conduct disruptive to the learning environment, and that such removals are not subject to a prior hearing, provided the removal is for a period of less than twenty-four (24) hours.

Per the policy Student 2023011, 2023012 and Student 2023013 have been recommended for expulsion and as outlined in the letters have been provided with further required documentation to petition for reinstatement back into the school.
