- Door Audits and Intruder Drills (Chief)
- Semi-Annual Maintenance Checks -must be checked and documented twice a year. (Eric)
 - 2025-2026 CH61 Semiannual maintenance check.xlsx
 - Physical Security & Access
 - Doors: Verify all exterior doors close, lock, and latch automatically, but allow emergency egress from inside.
 - Windows: Ensure all ground-level window locks are fully operational.
 - Perimeter: Inspect all fencing and gates for integrity.
 - Key Access: Confirm exterior master key boxes are functional and contain current keys.
 - Emergency Systems & Comms
 - Panic Alerts: Test that classroom/office alerts successfully reach staff and emergency responders.
 - 9-1-1 Data: Confirm phone systems provide accurate location data for emergency calls.

- Radio Check: Ensure two-way radios (Staff & Law Enforcement) operate effectively inside all buildings.

- Safety Grants (Eric)-current grant is the TPS safety grant for insurance coverage-related items, such as PPE or other occupational safety items. Any department is eligible, but we must submit together as one submission by April 30th. Keep in mind, this is a reimbursement grant, meaning funds are needed up-front. A couple of suggestions are:
 - Student sidewalk from HS to AG Barn and Tennis connector.
 - Additional wet floor signs and barricades for new schools
 - Additional AED's and bleed stop kits
 - First aid training for staff
 - Lighting upgrades for CTE building
 - Stopsaw tablesaw for the maintenance shop
 - Any fire and life safety deficiencies district wide noted on the fire marshal or insurance inspection reports.
