The Board, through the presiding officer or Superintendent, can offer factual information, cite Board policy, or direct the administration to investigate items and report back to the Board, but shall not engage in a two-way dialogue with patrons.

Background Information	<p>WHY: The Board of Trustees adopts the instructional calendar annually as part of it's larger responsibility of adopting and maintaining a budget.</p> <p>WHAT: Administration will provide a recommendation to consider for the 25-26 School Calendar.</p> <p>Data: Multiple stakeholder groups provided feedback in a community survey that was overwhelmingly in favor (87%) of keeping a pink day hybrid style calendar. The Calendar Committee met three times and was composed of 60 members (teachers, staff, campus and district leaders and parents). DEIC also provided input into this process. Four calendar drafts were developed as a result of the Calendar Committee's work and were presented to parents and staff to rank according to their preference. The calendar recommended by administration tonight for consideration is DRAFT A of the four reviewed by the community. It was the number one ranked calendar by parents and staff alike.</p>

"Student C" is unable to attend public school due to treatment for cancer that prevents exposure to other individuals.</p> <p>For the waiver application "D", remote homebound instruction will be provided to "Student D", a Midlothian High School general education student. With the approval of a waiver request, the student can be counted in attendance for funding purposes provided that all requirements of the homebound program are met except for face-to-face instruction from the homebound teacher.
