Operating Levy Inflationary Adjustments

Ehlers Financial reviewed the revised referendum cap inflation adjustments that were released by the Minnesota Department of Education on June 30, 2022. Ehlers and Finance Director Brady Hoffman discussed with the School Board how the 1.78% inflation adjustment affects the revenue that South St. Paul Public Schools generates.

School Resource Officer

Superintendent Brian Zambreno presented a proposed agreement with the City of South St. Paul for School Resource Officer (SRO) services. Both entities believe the SRO is an integral partner for creating a safe school environment and building positive relationships with our students, staff, families and SSP community. The proposed agreement for 2022-2024 will go before the School Board for approval this evening.
