5. A. Superintendent's Report

- i. Legislative update - attached.
- ii. Calendar change request:
 1. Superintendent recommends April 26, 2024 to be changed from an Early Release day to a full non-student, staff development day. The purpose of the full day is to begin READ Act training and PLC work toward improving instruction. We have not used any snow days this year and are 5 days above state requirements for students in school.

- iii. Valedictorian for 2024 is Julia Rosin
Salutatorian for 2024 is Conner Martens
- iv. Negotiations: Nicollet Public School and Nicollet Education Association have reached a tentative agreement. Details are attached to the consent agenda. Due to the terms agreed for necessary salary improvements and declining student enrollment the Superintendent recommends the Board adopt a resolution directing the administration to make staff reductions equal to 2.0 FTE for the 24-25 school year.
- v. Audit: The 2023 audit is nearing completion. The Superintendent recommends a Special meeting May 1 at 5:00 so KDB can present in person the final audit report. The Board can choose to wait until the scheduled Board meeting May 8, 2034 but the presenter is only available virtually..
- vi. Nicollet County District Court - State of Minnesota v. Former Employee
The first hearing was briefly held March 19, 2024. The defense attorney requested that another hearing be held. The next hearing is scheduled for

Legislative Update

April 5, 2024

The legislature is moving toward adjournment. The State Constitution requires adjournment by Monday, May 20th.

On Tuesday the Senate took up the Education Policy Bill (SF 3567 Cwodzinski). The bill contains a number of provisions:

- Government and citizenship course requirement is delayed one year
- Rename “World’s Best Workforce” to “Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness”.
- Rename “Achievement Gap” to “Opportunity Gap”
- Prohibits a school district from disciplining teachers for discussing incidents of violence or dangerous conduct
- Rejected an amendment to authorize lawsuits against educators who display “obscene material” to students (ruled non germane)
- Adopted a one-year extension for schools to change American Indian Mascots
- Adopted School Newspaper Bill, limiting review of school newspaper content
- Adopted provision requiring parental notification and record of students pulled out of class for 10 minutes or more
- Adopted provision requiring MSHSL to provide instruction to coaches on eating disorders
- Adopted provision requiring schools to provide students with access to mental health services through telehealth

Senator Farnsworth moved to have math standards determined locally. The intent was to delete Algebra II from the graduation requirement.

The House Education Policy Bill (HF 3782 Pryor) was scheduled on the floor Thursday. The bill contains many of the same provisions as the Senate bill. After adoption the House and Senate will meet to confirm the final positions.

In the next two weeks the House and Senate Finance committees will decide how to spend \$43 million. It is expected that the bulk of the money will be spent on the READ Act.

The Pension Commission posted the omnibus bill:

The bill extends the earnings limitation for individuals who return to work after retirement. The extension goes through fiscal years 2024, 2026, 2027. Last year the normal retirement age was reduced from age 66 to age 65. This provision was effective beginning July 1, 2025. The bill moves this date to July 1, 2024.

The biggest hurdle for the legislature is to pass a bonding bill. This requires a super majority, so the republicans have to agree with the democrats to pass the bill.

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2023-2024 Negotiations Summary

- Item PP: 2% year 1 (2023-24) salary increase, 5.8% year 2 (2024-25) salary increase
- Item P: \$860 year 1 (January 1, 2024-December 31, 2024) insurance contribution, \$920 year 2 (January 1, 2025-December, 31 2025). Currently our expired contract is a \$775 contribution.
- Item E: Official dates for extracurricular pay (newly added language is in green): *The compensation for extracurricular personnel will be paid in two installments. The first installment shall be paid half way through the regular season on September 20, January 20 or April 20, and the second installment shall be paid November 5th, March 5th, and June 5th. All other extracurriculars will be paid in full on or before June 5th.*
- Item I: Longevity pay will be paid on June 5th paycheck. Currently it is being done in the middle of the year in December, but there is no official language stating that that is what can be expected.
- Item J Longevity Pay: We are striking the requirement that in order to receive longevity pay for 15+ years of service that you have to have been at Nicollet for those 15+ years. Instead, it will now be that you will receive that annual payment if you have 15+ years of experience teaching in any district.
- Item R: New language regarding the new statute on sick and safe leave
- Item JJ: New language regarding grading time at quarters. *Following 1st and 3rd quarter grading periods the district will provide at least one-half day dedicated to grading and the evaluation of students. Following semester 1 and semester 2 the district will provide one full day dedicated to grading and evaluation of students.*
- Item MM: 403b match increased. New amounts are district match of \$800 starting in the year of a continuing contract (when you're tenured) through year 8, a district match of \$1000 for years 9-12, and a district match of \$12 for years 13+. It was \$600 for years 4-8, \$800 years 9-12, and \$1000 years 13+ previously
- Item NN (new portion is in green): *A teacher terminating employment after having reached TRA eligibility for retirement, and has served 20 years or more in the District, shall upon retirement, receive a \$5,000 deposit in July of each year into a HCSP administered by MSRS until eligible for Medicare. Was previously \$4500*
- Section 4. Salary Payments: Subd. 1- The salaries of all teachers will be paid bi-monthly basis. The checks will be paid on the 5th and 20th of each month. If the 5th or 20th falls on a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday, pay day will be the preceding school day or Friday.
 - ~~In 10 equal payments during the work year, with the final payment due on the last day of school.~~
 - In (12)-24 equal payments over the full calendar year. Checks that are mailed during June, July, and August, will be mailed on the 4th and 19th of the month and checks that are direct deposited will follow the monthly payroll schedule.
 - Two teachers who currently receive their checks over a 10 month period will be allowed to continue until they leave the district or choose the 12 month period.

NEA voted in favor of the agreement April 5, 2024.
